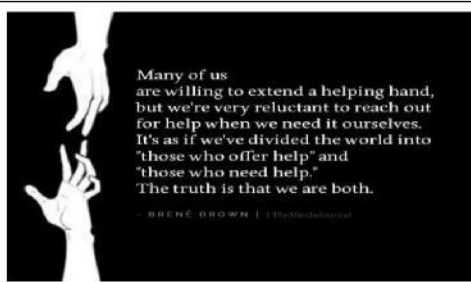

My experience with tradition six:

My home group decided to get an alcoholic association board to help all the alcoholics in our area. They got a building and turned it into a men's center. It was going great helping men to recover from alcoholism and become productive citizens. They started AA meeting there. It was really a wonderful place! So many were being helped. First problem was how to be funded- as it grew argument started happening over money and who was in charge. Then people started dropping off the board, then they decided to open it up to women. Problems arose with relationships happening in the house. Clients who graduated from the program could become house managers. A house manager propositioned a female client so she could get a room and this young woman went to the newspaper- all hell broke loose. The AA program was dragged through the mud. The facility closed down and a very good lesson was learned- do not mix AA with outside enterprises. Our groups name was all over the newspaper. We were not very anonymous at that point. This was a lesson learned. Thank God for tradition six.
