## What to Know

### WHEN TO ARRIVE/RETURN

**IF TAKING THE BUS:** arrive at Abiding Shepherd Lutheran Church (406 W. Cottage Grove Road, Cottage Grove) at 2:00 pm to begin loading luggage. The bus will leave for Camp Luwisomo at 2:30 pm sharp!! On Friday, the bus will return to Abiding Shepherd at 2:30 p.m.

**IF DRIVING:** arrive at Camp Luwisomo (W5421 Aspen Rd, Wild Rose, WI 54984) between 4:00 pm and 4:45 pm. On Friday, please pick up your child at 12:30 p.m. Campers may depart early if prior arrangements are made with Pastor Nate.

### CANTEEN

Twice each day campers have the opportunity to "purchase" snacks (1 drink, 1 crunchy snack, 1 sweet snack) from the camp canteen store. Rather than handling money at camp, this year all canteen money must be turned in with the final payments for Camp Rise, by June 1. A canteen card, reflecting the available balance for each camper, will then be used during camp to "purchase" snacks or other items. \$30 for canteen is usually plenty. Any remaining balance at the end of the week will be sent home with the campers.
