Mitzvah Garden

The B'nai Israel Mitzvah Garden is maintained by a group of dedicated volunteers committed to providing nourishing vegetables to our food-challenged neighbors in Southbury and Woodbury. During this past growing season, we contributed over 100 pounds of vegetables, including tomatoes, peppers, cucumbers, carrots, celery, kale, various lettuces and beans to the Southbury and Woodbury Food Banks.

Our volunteers perform a variety of tasks ranging from working the soil, planting the seeds, tending the weeds and harvesting the vegetables. Those who are not inclined to work the soil can deliver the produce or help with procuring donations for seedlings and supplies. Every one of these tasks is essential for the production of these precious vegetables. No experience is necessary! You can learn from more experienced gardeners as you spend meaningful time tending to the garden with fellow congregants.

The Mitzvah Garden operates from March to October with the busiest months being June, July and August. Please contact me if you are interested in getting involved.

Resettlement of Refugees

New Start Ministry is an interfaith group based in Woodbury that welcomes refugees to the United States and helps them resettle in the Greater Waterbury area. With each family that arrives, members of New Start Ministry form different committees, each focused on supporting the new family in a different area such as finding a home and furnishing it, teaching them about dealing with finances in the U.S., teaching them English, helping them understand the culture in the United States, helping them find employment, etc.

New Start Ministry is currently helping an Afghan refugee family of four. They arrived nine weeks ago and are doing well. The children are enjoying school (pre-K and Kindergarten), the father has been working part-time for now so he has time to work on improving his English, and the mother is working hard at Adult ESL and is looking forward to taking the DMV test.

If you are interested in volunteering, there are still some opportunities to help this family. New Start Ministry is seeking people to assist with driving family members for activities such as school and medical appointments. Perhaps you prefer working with children? Then please consider volunteering to assist with childcare, needed when the parents are involved with meetings and with appointments outside the apartment. Another important need is for ESL tutors, mastery of English is crucial for their successful resettlement.


