

I learned a lot about the dreaded Holocaust. Songs and words churned inside my head, so as I often do I wrote a poem to capture those feelings:

I heard stories and songs and imagined the feelings, grief, pain, disbelief, and agony that the prisoners felt and experienced. This played out like a movie in my mind, picturing what that would have been like. I could really feel it.

How? Why? I could not, and have not stopped thinking about what happened. It really moved me and has made me appreciate my faith even more.
