

This month's recipe is shared by Rochelle Gershenow

This recipe has become a Thanksgiving tradition in our family. I believe I adapted it from a recipe, years ago, in the New York Times.

Sweet Potato Casserole (serves 8)

3 lb. sweet potatoes 1 cup milk

3 eggs separated ½ t vanilla extract

4 T butter 12 pecan or walnut halves

1 t salt granulated brown sugar

Cook sweet potatoes unpared 25 – 35 minutes (until soft).

Peel while hot & mash. Beat in egg yolks one at a time.

Beat in butter, salt, vanilla, & milk.

Beat egg whites till stiff, fold into sweet potato mixture.

Grease ovenproof casserole dish.

Spoon in sweet potato mixture.

Place nut halves at intervals on top.

Lightly sprinkle w/brown sugar until covered.

Bake at 350 about 40 minutes.
