Honey Butter Skillet Corn

Honey Butter Skillet Corn is the perfect sweet corn side dish for any meal. This recipe comes together in less than 15 minutes and is made with only 6 simple ingredients! You'll love the creamy honey butter sauce so much, this might be your new favorite easy corn recipe.

Ingredients

- 16 ounces frozen corn
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 2 ounces cream cheese
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper

Instructions

1. In a large skillet, heat the frozen corn over medium-high heat, stirring often, until hot.
2. Add the honey and butter and stir until the butter is melted. Cut the cream cheese into small chunks and add them to the corn, along with the salt and pepper.
3. Allow the cream cheese to melt, then stir until completely melted into the honey butter sauce.
4. Serve the corn hot.
