### [PROPOSED] ORDER REGARDING BELAIRE NOTICE TO PROPOSED SETTLEMENT CLASS MEMBERS

For good cause shown, the Court hereby ORDERS the following:

- 1. The *Belaire* Notice attached as Exhibit 1 is hereby approved for dissemination to Settlement Class members.<sup>1</sup>
- 2. The Court appoints Epiq Class Action & Claims Solutions, Inc., as Settlement Administrator.
- 3. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of the Preliminary Approval Order, a complete list of all Settlement Class members and their available contact information, including (to the extent available) each Settlement Class member's full name, email address, last known mailing address, and dates of employment with Facebook's Vendor(s) as Content Moderators for Facebook shall be sent to the Settlement Administrator.
- 4. On or before September 9, 2020, the Settlement Administrator shall send the *Belaire*Notice to Settlement Class members by email or, if no email address is available, their last known U.S.

  Mail address. The costs of providing *Belaire* Notice shall be paid out of the Settlement Fund.
- 5. The Settlement Administrator shall collect objections and report to Plaintiffs' counsel and Defense counsel on the number of objections received.
  - 6. Objections may be made by electronic mail or United States mail.
- 7. For a disclosure objection to be valid, the Settlement Class member must either (a) email their name to info@contentmoderatorsettlement.com on or before October 9, 2020 and state that they object to the disclosure of their name and contact information or (b) complete and postmark the enclosed disclosure objection form with their name, signature, and date by the same deadline.

If the Settlement Class member's intent is ambiguous in the objection, the Settlement Administrator shall provide a copy of the disclosure objection to the Parties' counsel, who shall meet and confer to resolve the ambiguity.

- 8. The Settlement Administrator shall prepare a report under oath of its process for distributing the *Belaire* Notice and collecting the disclosure objections.
  - 9. Within ten (10) business days after the deadline for Settlement Class members to object

There is a Proposed Settlement in a class action lawsuit filed in the Superior Court of California, San Mateo County (Case No. 18CIV05135) by Selena Scola, Erin Elder, Gabriel Ramos, April Hutchins, Konica Ritchie, Allison Trebacz, Jessica Swarner, and Gregory Shulman (collectively, "Plaintiffs"), former employees of companies that contracted with Facebook, Inc. ("Facebook") to review Facebook's content. The Proposed Settlement affects a "Class," or group, of people that includes you.

You are receiving this Notice because you are a member of the Settlement Class. This is not a lawsuit against you, and you are not being sued. This notice is approved by the Court and is designed to give you an opportunity to object to the disclosure of your name, address, telephone number, and email address, and date(s) of employment to attorneys for the Plaintiffs and Defendant.

Plaintiffs filed the lawsuit to obtain damages and declaratory and equitable relief to protect the interests of themselves and all Content Moderators who reviewed content for Facebook through a third-party contractor.

Plaintiffs allege that Facebook failed to provide a safe workplace for Content Moderators employed through third-party vendors of Facebook, in violation of California law. Plaintiffs allege that this failure contributed to Content Moderators suffering from psychological trauma, including but not limited to Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD). Defendant Facebook denies all these allegations in their entirety and maintains that it has complied with all applicable laws. The Parties agreed to the Proposed Settlement to provide relief to the class and to avoid further expense associated with this litigation.

In connection with the Settlement, a Settlement Administrator will be provided with the names, email addresses, last known addresses, and date(s) of employment of all members of the Settlement Class, including you.

The Parties' attorneys have agreed to use this information only for purposes of this lawsuit and have agreed not to disclose this information to anyone else.

This notice is being sent to you so that you can decide whether to have your contact information provided to the Parties' attorneys. Your decision will NOT affect your rights under the Settlement, including your rights to any relief the Settlement may provide.

<u>OPTION ONE</u>: If you want your name, email address, mailing address, and date(s) of employment to be disclosed to the Parties' attorneys, you do not need to do anything.

<u>OPTION TWO</u>: If you do **not** want your name, email address, mailing address, and date(s) of employment to be disclosed to the Parties' attorneys, you must email to info@contentmoderatorsettlement.com or sign the enclosed pre-paid and self-addressed postcard and return it to the Settlement Administrator at the address on the postcard.
