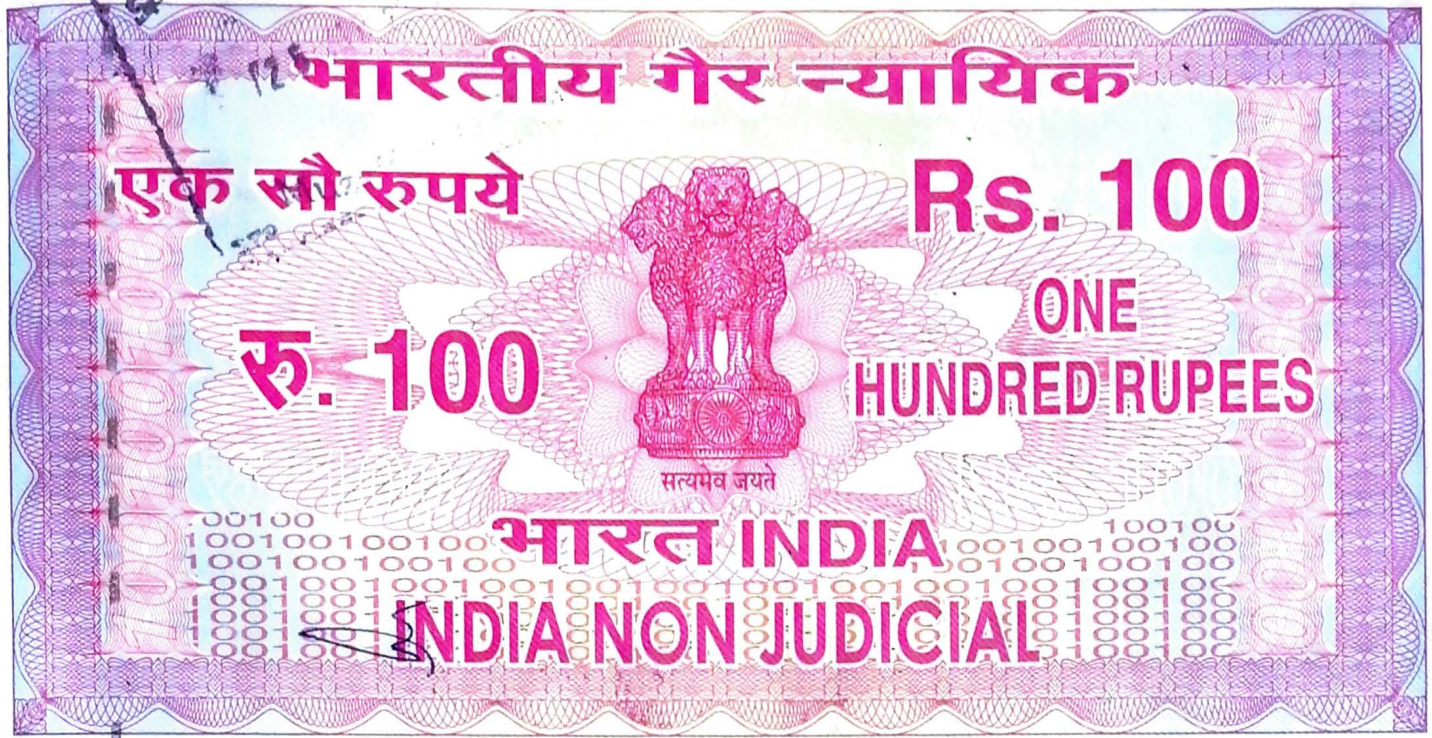

The Trustee 'a' and 'b' shall have full and unfettered power to regulate and manage the affairs of the Trust in order to fulfill the objects of the Trust **Jointly**. In the eventuality of trustee "a" and "b" the legal heir will be appointed as a trustee and carry out the functions of the trust and will have full authority and powers as current founder trustee "a" and "b" have.

And whereas the trustees have, agreed to act as the first trustees. And whereas it is necessary to declare the objects and terms of the public charitable trust, being constituted under these presents.

3. INITIAL CORPUS FUND:

The initial corpus of the fund of the Trust will be RS.10000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only)

4. TRUST PROPERTIES:

The Trust property comprise the said initial corpus of the Trust found together with all the contributions, additions, accumulations and accretions to the said money and the conversion thereof and the investments in which the same may from time to time be invested or other moveable and immovable properties and assets that may from time to time be vested in the Trustee or be received by them by way of donations or otherwise or acquired by them or may come to their hand by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to the Trust hereby created. The Trust property shall vest in the Trustee, herein upon the Trust, subject to the provision here of for the fulfillment of the object of the Trust.

5. REGISTERED OFFICE:

The present registered address of the Trust shall be **"509, North Civil Line, Muzaffarnagar - 251001"** or any other place as may be decided by the "Board of Trustees".

The present coordination office of the trust will be at "Vill – Rahakada, Near Gurudwara, Tehsil - Jansath Dist – Muzaffarnagar 251001". The office may be opened at any other place of places across the country and abroad that the Trustee may decide from time to time.

6. NATURE OF THE TRUST:

This Trust shall be a public charitable Trust having no profit motives. It shall be maintained and administered to for the promotion of Physical & Mental Health.

For the benefit of public, mental and physically disabled, under privileged children and adults and other objects of the general public in India and abroad without any distinction/discrimination. The Trust property including its fund and income shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects for which this

Trust is established. ..

The area of the operation will be the whole of India and abroad.

S. AIMS, OBJECTS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE TRUST:

The objects of the Trust are, -

1. To establish, develop, maintain and grant aid in cash or in kind to hospitals, medical schools, medical colleges, nursing institutions, dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers and/or such other similar charitable institutions in India for the benefit and use of the general public.
2. To establish, run, support and grant aid or other financial assistance to schools, special schools for disables & mentally challenged, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, universities, laboratories, research and other institutions of the like nature in India, for use of the students and the staff and also for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general.
3. To establish, maintain and run studentships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to students including supply of books, stipends, medals and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste colour, race, creed or sex.
4. To provide formal or non - formal education for all children and adults without any distinction of caste, creed, color or community or religion.
5. To promote, establish, support, maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts, for the preservation of historical monuments and for the research and other institutions, in India, having similar objects for the benefit of the public in general.
6. To establish, maintain or grant aid to vocational training centers for the economically backward
7. To establish, maintain or grant aid to any project or program which is the public charitable or educational purposes.
8. To establish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment of parks, gardens, gymnasiums, sports clubs, dharamshalas and rest houses, for use by public in general.
9. To work in the field of mental health for benefit of children, women, adults and person suffering from any mental illness by using medical treatment, psychotherapy, counseling and rehabilitation facilities and all round development of the persons with disabilities (Mentally retarded, physically handicapped, and person with multiple disabilities), mental illness and economically disadvantaged children and adults by using special education techniques, therapeutic work, recreational activities, vocational training, guidance and counseling etc. in all possible manners.

19. To promote collaborative efforts & linkage with existing NGOs and institutes in India and abroad for the welfare of underprivileged/ Person with disability and mental illness to fulfill the above objectives and to promote & collaborate with national & international bodies/ NGOs including running branches.
20. To protect the human rights of general public at all levels and to launch and promote the health programs for all age groups.
21. To grant aid or render assistance to other public charitable trusts or institutions.
22. To establish, maintain or grant aid to environmental programs to save the environment.
23. To help and develop special programs for the women and self help groups.
24. To explore ways for promotion of socioeconomic development in the community.
25. To undertake, organize, conduct and facilitate, Courses, conference, lecture, research and education on various aspects and of science, technology, trust and other fields
26. To work for the welfare of trust neglected and martingales people.
27. To aid or establish any institution technical or otherwise, to promote education of art, Science or other related fields for the benefit of downtrodden and weaker sections of the trust.
28. To arrange and provide medical aid and other assistance necessary for living to the needy people who are incapable or handicapped or mentally/physically retarded and financially unfit.
29. To construct, maintain, alter, improve or develop any building belonging to the trust or works necessary or convenient for purpose of the trust.
30. To arrange / establish and maintain centers of adult education, vocational education technical training, and low cost education, formal & non-formal education.
31. To fight against HIV/AIDS and other communicable diseases.
32. To acquire, purchase or otherwise own or under take on loan or lease or hire temporality or permanently and movable or immovable property necessary or convenient for the furtherance of the objects of the trust.
33. To organized and take-up Health, Educational and Welfare programmes for needy & poor Women & Children.
34. To promote and protect Indian Traditional music, dance, handicraft, handlooms, Art, modern art & literature.
35. To establish an award for the deserving people in the field of Music, Art grass root level social service, communal harmony, brotherhood and peace.
36. To establish centre(s) for the promotion of Music, Dance and other Arts.
37. To work for Environmental Protection, Forestation, Plantation, Waste Land Management.

To hold training workshops, seminars & awareness programs for the community workers, teachers, therapists, parents or siblings, care takers & society for the above mentioned objectives and to spread the information among the people about arts, music and their uses for psychological treatments, educational purposes and all round development of the persons with disabilities and economically disadvantaged children, women & adults.
11. To bring Persons with mental & physical disabilities into the mainstream by show casing their talent and abilities through performing arts, social and cultural program, painting, music, games, and other education and vocational skills to enhance their mental and physical development and building social relationships and creating an inclusive environment that allows to able and the disabled to learn, work, and play together.
12. To establish the psycho-social counseling centers, clinic, neuropsychiatric centers and rehabilitation centers for treatment of mentally and physically ill and under privilege children and adults and to establish the special counseling and treatment programs focusing on geriatrics for old age people for their mental and psycho- social illness and problem and to establish the old age homes, orphanage, rehabilitation centers and mental asylums for the benefit of people at large.
13. To arrange; establish, built, alter, or take on rent and building for housing the institution, and run a primary or higher secondary school, educational/vocational school/institute or training centre, and office, established by the society to provide the general education and training to the students of all sections, and also to bring the education and vocational training within the reach of poor and backward children at the lowest possible cost and provide hostels, and residences for students and staff members if considered necessary for the attainment of its objectives.
14. To hold the awareness programs and medical camps for life hazard diseases like- AIDS, CANCER, STD and DIABITIES etc.
15. To provide scholarships, stipends, to the candidates whom the society may considered be deserving to enable them to receive further education, training, and other qualifications in any respective school, institute, office, and training centers to provide opportunities for further learning to both students and workers.
16. To acquire, hold, purchases, sale, exchange, lease and turn to account all kinds of properties, movable and immovable for purposes connected with or conducive to the promotion of the objectives of the society as per law.
17. To collect subscription, grants and aids, funds or other charity *from* persons bodies and Govt. and borrow money or otherwise and deposit money in such manner as may be deemed fit and utilize the same for the furtherance of the aims and objectives

38. To organized vocational training for women and needy people.
39. To aware people about their democratic & fundamental rights.
40. To promote cottage industries, *Khadi*, and traditional handicraft.
41. To advocate *Poanchayti Raj* system among citizens.
42. To provide various medical services such as organizing health and awareness camps of Immunization, Eye Care, Motherhood, Child Care, and Communicable Diseases.

49. To establish the medical facilities in the working locality (if required) such as family planning centers, dispensaries, hospitals etc.
50. To run and open the schools for the welfare and uplift of the needy children and also run adult education programmes.
51. To publish books, magazines, charts, issue related IEC (Information, Education and Communication) materials and other periodical illustration for generating the income for the trust for the benefit of its aims.
52. To open / run / manage institute / collage of higher / professional / vocation education in any part of the country for providing quality education and training to youth and children.
53. To promote traditional therapies like Yoga, Naturopathy, Meditation, Acupressure, Acupuncture, Massage Therapy, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Reiki etc.
54. To establish, build or manage Hostels, Short Stay Homes, Rehabilitation Centers, Shelters, Crèches, Child Care Centre or Children's Home, Counseling Centers and Help Line Centers for Women, Children, Old aged persons, Drug addicts and needy persons.
55. To form women groups, youth groups, self help groups; old aged groups, adolescent groups, children groups/clubs, community leaders groups and group of volunteers.
56. To promote traditional games along with the contemporary sports among youth & others.
57. To establish Citizen Forum (s) and Resident Welfare Association (s) for the development of high values of the Unity, Brotherhood, Communal Harmony and Peace.
58. To take-up, initiate or assist social development activities or welfare programmes for bringing positive change in the lives of the common people.
59. All the incomes, earnings, movable / immovable properties of the trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and object only a set forth in the

Memorandum of the trust and no profit, thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any other manner whatsoever to the present or past members of the trust or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members.

60. No member of the trust shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the trust or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of this membership.

9. BOARD OF TRUSTEE

1. The "Founder Trustees", if feel necessary for successful achievement of objectives of the Trust can form a board of trustee, hereafter called as BOARD.
2. BOARD comprises not more than 7 members and they will be called as "Executive Trustees".
3. The tenure of Executive Trustee will be 5 years from the date of appointment and if Founder trustee feel necessary it can be renewed further.
4. The number of board members may be increased or decreased by the Trustee from time to time.
5. Amongst the Board of trustees they shall elect President, Secretary and Treasurer and their period of office will be 2 years (Two Years)
6. In the event of death, resignation or otherwise of any of founder trustee, the vacancy trusteeship shall pass onto the nominee/legal heir of the deceased, resigned or otherwise of such trustee and no other incumbent shall have any power of the founder trustee.
7. Only the founder trustees shall have power to vote and each of them shall have only one vote.

10. PRESENT BOARD MEMBERS OF TRUST ARE:

- 1) Mr. Deepak Kumar Rohal S/O Ompal Singh as Founder trustee of this Trust
- 2) Mr. Sanjay Kumar S/O Vijaypal Singh as Founder trustee of this Trust.
- 3) Mr Ompal Singh S/O Ishwar Singh as Executive Trustee.
- 4) Mr Chadrapal Singh S/O Jile Singh as Executive Trustee.
- 5) Mrs. Kamlesh Singh W/O Ompal Singh as Executive Trustee.
- 6) Mrs. Akshama Choudhary W/O Sanjay Kumar as Executive Trustee.
- 7) Mrs. Monika Choudhary W/O Deepak Kumar Rohal as Executive Trustee.

11. CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP IN BOARD:

A person shall cease to be a Member of the Trust in either of the following situations (NOT APPLICABLE TO FOUNDER MEMBER / FOUNDER TRUSTEE "a" and "b").

11.1) If he/she, without informing remains in active and does not attained three consecutive meetings of the Board.

11.2) If he /she are requested to resign by Trustees.

11.3) If he/she is not performing according to the objective of the trust then trustee will have power to cease the membership.

12 MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

- a) The board of Trustees shall meet as often as necessary but at least once in three months and their proceedings shall be recoded regularly in the minutes book to be retained for the purpose.
- b) In the absence of the President at any meeting, the Trustee present may elect one among them as Chairperson of the meeting.

13. FACILITIES AND DUTIES OF FOUNDER TRUSTEE:

The Trustees are not entitled for any remuneration. But they shall however be entitled to receive out of pocket expenses incurred by them in the course of discharging the functions of the Trust. The Founder trustees shall be entitled perks as decided by the trustees like equipped office, furnished house/equivalent allowance as per prevailing market, index and would get reimbursement of the expenses incurred in connection with and in favor of the Trust or their duties relating thereto including visits abroad for attend conference, workshop and exhibition etc.

Further the Income and funds of the Trust will be solely utilized towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilized for payment of Trustees by way profits, interest and dividend or otherwise.

If any of the founder trustees dies or become incapable to full fill his/her duties, the vacancy so caused would be filled by the nomination by trustee. The nomination of trustee has same power as founder trustee.

14. TRUST FUND:

All money, investment, donations, interests, rents, profits, contributions and other property, which may hereinafter be paid or transferred to or otherwise vested in the trust or so as to be under their control by any person or persons or which may at any time here in after in any other manner accrue to the capital of the trust fund. All such accumulations of income will be additions to the capital of the trust fund.

15. ACCOUNT OF TRUST:

1. The trustee shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust, which shall be kept at the office of the Trust.
2. A chartered accountant appointed by the trustee would audit account of expenditure.
3. The accounting year of the Trust shall be ending on 31st day of March of every year.
4. The Trust fund shall be and remain irrevocable for all times.

5. The fund of the Trust would be kept in an account opened in any Bank or Post Office. The Founder Trustee "a" would operate it jointly with the Founder Trustee "b".
6. Nothing contained in this deed shall be deemed to authorized trustees to do any act which may in any way be constructed statutory modifications thereof and all activities of the Trust shall be carried out with a view of with the provision of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modifications thereof.

16. POWERS OF TRUSTEES:

That for the furtherance of the objects of the trust, the trustees shall have the following powers:

1. To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or kind, from any person(s), body of persons or trust, with or without conditions.
2. To apply the whole or any part of the income of the trust, or the trust fund or accumulations thereto, to any one or more of the objects of the trust, as the trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
3. To convert and deal with the trust property and/or any investments for the time being.
4. To invest the Trust Fund either in the purchase of immovable property or investments, or in deposits with public sector or nationalized or scheduled banks or other investments specified in section 11(5) of the Income tax Act and to alter, vary or transpose such investments, from time to time at the discretion of the trustees.
5. To borrow or raise moneys and also to lend money to students for education.
6. To sell, dispose of alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund with the prior approval of Commissioner / Director of Income Tax.
7. To let out, demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust Fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
8. To open bank accounts in the name of the Trust, Trustees and/or Institutions run/conducted by the Trust with Nationalized or Scheduled Bank or Banks, to operate such account and to give instructions to the Bank and to provide for opening and operation of such account by the Trustees or by an agent appointed by the Trustees.
9. To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitrations, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.

10. To appoint constituted attorneys or agents and to delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the powers vested on them under these presents and from time to time remove such attorneys or agents and to appoint other or others in his or their place.
11. To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including committees of the Trustees or administrator or changing Managing Trustee) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this Deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may from time to time think fit.
12. To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.
13. To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
14. To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
15. To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
16. To borrow moneys either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund with the approval of the Commissioner / Director of Income tax or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payments on such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
17. To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to conform to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
18. To take over or amalgamate any other charitable trust, society, association, or institution with similar objects.

19. To establish, promote, manage, organize or maintain or to assist in establishing, promoting, managing, organizing, or maintaining any branch of the Trust or any other Trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this Trust and to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other Trust with this Trust.
20. To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
21. To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
22. To transfer all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of this Trust to any one or more of the trust, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate with the approval of the Commissioner / Director of Income tax.
23. The trustees may establish the office of the trust at such place or places as they see fit and may change such places within India from time to time as they may think suitable. Also they can establish the branch offices or project offices for the convenience of the operation of the trust in India.
24. TO MAKE INVESTMENTS: The trustee shall keep and maintain the account or accounts of the deposits of the Trust fund with any person, companies; or any other fund or institutions as they may, in their absolute discretion think fit subject nevertheless to the compliance of all legal formalities necessary and under the laws for the time being force to public charities.
25. TO ACCEPT DONATIONS: The Trust shall have the power in their discretion to accept such donations as they may think fit in cash or in kind of any property or assets of any nature from any private or public trust, institutions company firm or persons provided always that terms upon which such donations or contribution shall be accepted shall not in any way be consistent with or repugnant to the objects of these presents to be and shall be for the purpose of advancement of the Objects of the Trust created under these presents to be utilized only in furtherance of the objects.
26. TO MAKE DONATIONS: The trustees in majority shall similarly have powers to make donations or contributions from income and or trust funds or corpus weather in cash or other than cash or in kind to my trust, society or institutions on such terms and conditions as they shall in their absolute discretion think fit and proper.

29. TO APPLY TRUST FUNDS THROUGH OTHER CHARITABLE TRUSTS OR INSTITUTIONS: To pay any sum for such purposes to any charitable trust or institutions of similar nurture or to individuals or group of individuals to help for learn and earn. The trustees may decide it in majority and make such transactions accordingly.
30. TO APPOINT EMPLOYEES: The trustees any appoint any other proper officers and agents to assist in administration and managements of the trust and the application of trust fund any such appointment may be made for such terms and at such salaries or remuneration as may be decided by the trustees
31. AMENDMENT: That Subject to terms of this deed, trustees may from time to time prescribe and alter rules for management and administration of the trust for holding the meeting of the trustees and for other matter relating to the carrying of the object of the trust. All such rules will be written and signed by the founder trustees.

17. SUITS BY AND AGAINST TRUST:

The trust may sue or be sued in the name of trust.

18. DISSOLUTION OF THE TRUST:

That at any stage if the trustees find it impossible for any reason to carry on the activities of the trust they maybe to 2/3rd majority decide to windup the trust and also by same majority transfer the properties of trust to any organization with the similar aims and objects.

19. PROCEEDING OF THE TRUST:

Any defect in the constitution of the Trust shall not invalidate its proceedings

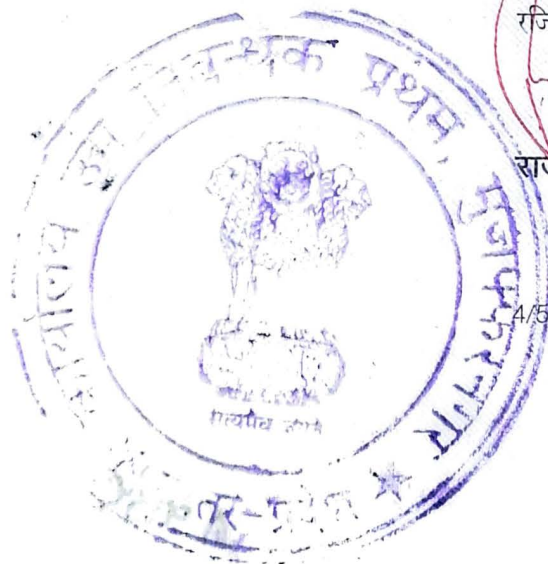
