ORDER


Before the Court is the Receiver’s Motion for Entry of Corrected Order [ECF No. 164] Granting Receiver’s Motion for Authority to Consummate Sales of Aircraft [ECF No. 131] (“Motion”). ECF No. 168. By Order dated March 18, the Court authorized the Receiver to consummate certain aircraft sales, including “the sale of the Canadair LTD Cl-600-B261.” ECF No. 164. Receiver informs the Court that its Order “contained an inadvertent transposition of the airplane model number” and requests the Court correct the airplane’s model number to “Canadair LTD CL-600-2B16.” ECF No. 168 at 2.

The Court ordered any party objecting to the Receiver’s Motion file an objection by April 1, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. ECF No. 171. The same Order directed the Receiver to notify all unrepresented parties and interested persons. *Id.* The Receiver complied (ECF Nos. 172-73), and the record reflects no party or person filed an objection.

The Court thus **GRANTS** the Motion (ECF No. 168) for good cause shown and because it is unopposed. Accordingly, the Court’s March 18 Order (ECF No. 164) shall be modified such that the Receiver is “authorized to consummate the sale of the **Canadair LTD CL-600-2B16.**”

Except as modified by this Order, the March 18 Order (ECF No. 164) remains in full force and effect.

It is so **ORDERED** on April 4, 2022.
