## ORDER REQUIRING ADDITIONAL BRIEFING ON PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AGAINST DEFENDANT RUSTIN BRUNSON

Before the Court is Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's Status Report Regarding Preliminary Injunction Hearing (ECF No. 33), filed December 10, 2021. There, the SEC explains that all defendants agreed to preliminary injunctions. The Court has granted all but one of the agreed motions. *See* ECF Nos. 40–44. The remaining motion is against Mr. Rustin

Brunson. As explained in Plaintiff's Status Report, Mr. Brunson seeks to add a provision titled "No 'Bad Actor' Disqualification," which the SEC opposes. ECF No. 33.

The Court **ORDERS** the parties to file additional briefing on why this provision should or should not be included. Briefs must be submitted **no later than 5:00 pm on Monday, December 13, 2021.**
