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

**ORDER**

Before the Court are Receiver's Motion (1) for Authority to Sell Oil and Gas Interests; (2) for Authority to Retain Sales and Marketing Firm; and (3) for Approval of Sales Procedures (ECF No. 197) and Receiver's Fee Application for Services Performed Between January 1, 2022 and March 31, 2022 and Brief in Support (ECF No. 198). The Court finds that expedited briefing is necessary to consider the Motion and Application in a timely fashion. *See* L.C.R. 7.1.

Any party or person opposing the Motion or Application **SHALL FILE** a response on or before **June 6, 2022**. The Court **SETS** the Motion and Application for a **hearing**, via telephone, on **June 8, 2022, at 10:00 a.m.** The dial-in number is: (877) 873-8017. The Clerk will email or otherwise provide the code to access the hearing to the other parties' counsel of record. By **May 18, 2022, at noon**, the Receiver **SHALL** transmit a copy of this Order to all unrepresented parties and interested persons, and the Receiver thereafter **SHALL** file proof of such transmission.
