INTRODUCTION TO THE 1989 STAR ALLIANCE DECLARATION & CELEBRATION FOR WORLD PEACE

**HISTORICAL NOTES FROM THE AUTHOR
2025 July 4th Weekend**

The accompanying, early edition of the STAR ALLIANCE Declaration for *Our Highest Civic Ideals*, an evolving document under its former title to the time, was signed by *His Holiness The Dalai Lama* (Please see just right of the thumbnail logo.) during his stay at the Fairmont Hotel in San Francisco, October 1989, and by a number of other VIP-luminaries.

In honor of His Holiness' 90th birthday — and the birth of the United States on July 4th, both — we are posting it online for the first time, to appear along with the latest, carefully-matured documents and support materials developed over the intervening years.

This appealingly brief, early edition was also signed by popular vocal star Sarah Brightman (Phantom of the Opera...), noted Environmentalists David Brower (Sierra Club / Earth Island) and Russell Peterson (Audubon Society); actor Eddie Fisher (father of Carrie Fisher, aka *Princess Lea*), 49er's football star Gene Washington, and Mr. Vladimir Azaroushkin, former Vice-Consular representative in San Francisco for the U.S.S.R..

Aspects and characteristics of this historical Declaration remain outstanding today, including its upbeat tone and advanced vision for a *Cooperative, participatory, non-factional, World Peace Quality-of-Life Media Network — For continuously enhancing appreciation, understanding, and rapport; helping to resolve conflicts peacefully; and creating practical friendships, People-to-People, Everywhere.*

Use of the term *Good Will* before the term *Peace* at the conclusion of the document is worth emphasizing. When Vice-Consul Azaroushkin approached me in the course of exiting a *World Affairs Council* reception on Market Street that same year — he seemed well aware already of the document displayed on an easel next to me in the lobby.

This was not surprising, as STAR ALLIANCE had regularly mailed or delivered copies of our updates to the Consulate on Green Street.

As a video cameraman stood by ready to record the action, we made friendly eye contact, and he stopped to greet me. I invited him to sign.

Mr. Azaroushkin acknowledged me with friendly respect. But seeing the pen I was offering, he hesitated and indicated, to the effect:

Yes, perhaps. But before signing, I have a question to ask. Don't you think it is a bit premature to celebrate peace? It seems there are so many things left still needing to be done!

Also to the effect, I replied. (The videotape has only recently been unearthed from historical records, and, in favor of preservation, is not yet viewed or transcribed.)

Yes, that's true. But at STAR ALLIANCE, we also feel that celebrating good things about each other's countries and cultures is an important part of the process of creating and sustaining peace.

"Ah!" he replied, with apparent satisfaction, relief, and now: enthusiasm.

Decisively, he took the pen from my hand, and signed.
