TONY BENNETT • Popular Singer, Artistic Collaborator • Signed c. 1988 — memorably en route, in an early "STAR ALLIANCE GOOD WILL TOURS" car, between Nob Hill and Union Square in San Francisco

LEONARD BERNSTEIN • Composer, *West Side Story*, and other classic works • Maestro Conductor, New York Philharmonic Orchestra, 1958—1969; Laureate Conductor for 21 additional years • Signed: 1986 August, at the Stanford Court Hotel, Nob Hill in San Francisco • (A private ceremony receiving the *Star of Peace Award* from STAR ALLIANCE historical Co-Founders, Peter B. DuMont and Ernest D. Siravo)

THEODORE BIKEL • Traditional folk singer and actor. Signed 2013 March 7th after a performance hosted by the 28th Annual Jewish Music Festival at Freight and Salvage coffeehouse theater, Berkeley, California

SARAH BRIGHTMAN • Singer • Signed c. 1989 after her performance at the *Golden Gate Theatre*, Market Street, San Francisco, California

DAVID BROWER • Environmentalist, First Executive Director, *Sierra Club*, 1952—1969 • Founder, Friends of the Earth & Earth Island Institute. Signed in 1989 after a conference hosted by *Physicians for Social Responsibility* at the Holiday Inn Van Ness, San Francisco, California

DAVE BRUBECK • Jazz Leader, The Dave Brubeck Quartet • Composer (*Take Five*, etc.) Signed 2003 June 13, Masonic Auditorium, San Francisco

KEN BURNS • Master Filmmaker-Documentarian • Signed during his reception with San Francisco's PBS affiliate, KQED, after his interview with academic expert Orville Schell, *City Arts and Lectures*, Herbst Theatre, 2002 January

HELEN CALDECOTT, MD • Nuclear Weapons Abolition Activist and Author • Signed 2002 January 25 • After her talk at First Congregational Church, Berkeley, California

HIS HOLINESS THE DALAI LAMA • Tibetan Buddhist Spiritual Leader • Signed in 1989 during a visit to San Francisco, California, at the historic *Fairmont Hotel* on Nob Hill (Where the United Nations Charter was drafted.)

LOUISE M. DAVIES • Philanthropist, patron of the arts, founding donor for *Davies Symphony Hall* • San Francisco. Signed at a private lunch at her home in Woodside, California

RONALD V. DELLUMS • U.S. Congressman from Oakland-Alameda County, California • Served as Chair of the House Armed Services Committee. Signed a Star Alliance Declaration on 1990 June 30th, after the historic *Nelson Mandela Victory Tour* dinner at the *Oakland Hyatt Regency Hotel* • Accepted sending the Star of Peace Award to Mr. Mandela • (Scores of citizens signed a Star Alliance Peace Declaration in the lobby that same evening, commemorating the event.)

JOHN DENVER • Singer and Environmental-Peace activist • *Star of Peace Award* recipient, 1986 • Shoreline Amphitheater, San Mateo, California • Signed a peace declaration for STAR ALLIANCE c. 1990, Circle Star Theatre, San Carlos, California

JOE DIMAGGIO • Baseball legend • Signed at reception for noted journalist Vladimir Pozner, hosted by Ms. Lia Belli at the Mark Hopkins Hotel, San Francisco, 1990 February. • (The original document was last known to be in the possession of Ms. Belli.)

PETE ESCOVEDO • Pioneer Latin Band Leader, *Azteca*, & Family Patriarch

LINDA FINCH • Aviator and founder *World Flight* • Recreated & completed Amelia Earhart's Round-the-World Flight • Signed a STAR ALLIANCE good will values declaration "*Safely Returned*" at Oakland Airport • 1997 May 28th

EDDIE FISHER • Singer-actor • Signed at home in San Francisco, late 1980s

GEORGE FOREMAN • Two-Time World Heavyweight Boxing Champion • Author & Promoter • Signed a STAR ALLIANCE Declaration 2006 August at Moscone Conference Center, San Francisco, California (Meeting facilitated by Henry C. Winston of Oakland.)

SIR BOB GELDOFF • Founder of the historic LIVE AID rock concerts for African Famine Relief • Signed a STAR ALLIANCE Declaration in late 2002, outside the historic Fillmore Theatre in San Francisco, California

PHILLIP GLASS • Avant-Garde Composer • Signed backstage at the University of California's Zellerbach Theatre in the mid-1990s

DANNY GLOVER • Actor • Signed 2011 November 30th at First Congregational Church of Berkeley, after a book talk by Harry Belafonte

DORIS KEARNS GOODWIN • Author-historian (<u>Team of Rivals</u> and many other books. Signed in 2005 on tour at the *Berkeley City Club*

JOHN & BONNIE GRAY • Signed 2007 Valentine's Week after a seminar held at the Berkeley Marina

DICK GREGORY • Pioneering Black Comedian • feted as *The Jackie Robinson of Comedy* by the <u>Washington Post</u> upon his death in 2017 at age 84. Signed in 1986 at Los Angeles

MAMADE KADREEBUX • Author-photographer-painter & raconteur • Signed in the early 2010's, in Berkeley, California

MINA KIM • Anchor Co-Host • KQED San Francisco's award-winning *Forum* radio talk show. Signed the 2023-7-7 Summary Pledge & Declaration on 2023 July 30th, after a KQED-LIVE studio event for educators

DENNIS KUCINICH • United States Congressman from Ohio, retired • Former presidential candidate • Key champion of a U.S. Department of Peace. Signed 2003 September 2 at McClymonds High School, Oakland, California

ROBIN LEACH • Longtime TV host of *Lifestyles of the Rich and Famous* • Pioneering TV travel host. Signed at MACY's San Francisco in the late 1980s

SHIRLEY MacLAINE • Actor, Singer, Dancer, and Author • Signed at the Orpheum Theatre on Market Street in San Francisco c. 1988

ALEXIS MADRIGAL • Anchor Co-Host • KQED San Francisco's award-winning *Forum* radio talk show. Signed the 2023-7-7 Summary Pledge & Declaration on 2023 July 30th, after a KQED-LIVE studio event for educators

SIDNEY MOBELL • Famous Jewelry Designer-Retailer, San Francisco • Signed c.1990

ROBERT MULLER • Chancellor, United Nations University for Peace, Costa Rica • Former Assistant Secretary General, United Nations. Signed mid-1990s

RUDOLPH NUREYEV • The late, great dancer • Signed at the Mark Hopkins Hotel in San Francisco at the reception for Vladimir Pozner, 1990 February

OAKLAND • CALIFORNIA • CITY COUNCIL • Unanimous Resolution of the Mayor and Council • 1995 April 18 (Same date as Paul Revere's Ride in 1775.) Note: Historic first governmental body to endorse a Star Alliance Declaration.

LINUS PAULING, PHD • World's sole, two-time undivided Nobel Prize recipient (Chemistry and Peace) • Also the historic first VIP STAR ALLIANCE document signer & STAR OF PEACE AWARD recipient, 1986 February (Reception at the home of Lee Swent, #1 King Street, Piedmont, California)

LUCIANO PAVAROTTI • Opera Tenor • Signed 1994 April, backstage at the San Jose Convention Center performance space.

VLADIMIR POZNER • Pioneering Russian T.V. Journalist and author • Co-host of many instrumental "Space-Bridges" of the 1980s, and Co-host, with Phil Donahue, on an American TV series, Star Alliance STAR OF PEACE Award Recipient (at a dinner event held at the historic Garden Room (drafting site, U.N. Charter) *The Fairmont Hotel*, San Francisco, California 1990 February)

JEAN-PIERRE RAMPAL • French flautist • Signed at Davies Symphony Hall, San Francisco, late 1980's

DEBBIE REYNOLDS • Actress, Singer • Signed after performance at the Golden Gate Theatre, Market Street, San Francisco

JERRY RICE • Superstar wide receiver • San Francisco 49ers • Signed 1990 January 29th • Super Bowl Parade, San Francisco

BABU CHIRI SHERPA • Mountain Climber • Ascended Mount Everest ten times before an accidental fatal fall in 2001. World's records: for fastest ascent of Everest, and for staying overnight at the summit (1999 May) without bottled oxygen! Carried the STAR ALLIANCE Arc of Rainbow Stars flag to the summit on three occasions, including his 21-hour overnight stay (1999 May) with our flag, and his speed record from base, under 17 hours, in 2000 May.

• Babu signed a STAR ALLIANCE Declaration of Ideals at the 14th Anniversary celebration for STAR ALLIANCE held1999 August, at the Lotus gourmet Chinese restaurant in Berkeley, California

HUSTON SMITH, Ph.D. • Pioneering author: <u>The World's Religions.</u> • Signed at the University of California, Berkeley, 1992 c. April

BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN • Rock star singer and songwriter • Signed a special edition for the *United Nations 50th Anniversary* • 1995 June, after a concert at the *Berkeley Community Theatre*, California.

CONNIE STEVENS • Singer • Signed in the late 1980's at a SOMA ("South of Market") club in San Francisco

TAKASHI TANEMORI • Survivor of the Atomic Bomb at Hiroshima • Author and Global Forgiveness Leader • Signed 2009 December 2nd at the Unitarian Church of San Francisco on Franklin Street, after an event sponsored by *The World March for Peace*

MARK THOMPSON • Colorful TV, radio, and podcast entertainment and cause-supporter personality. Thompson was weatherman with San Francisco Bay Area station KRON (an NBC affiliate at the time) when he signed and helped support Star Alliance in the late 1980s

CHARLES TOWNES, Ph.D. • Nobel Laureate who discovered the laser. Signed the 2008-12-2 edition during a Berkeley campus event sponsored by the *International Institute for the Bengal & Himalayan Basin* (IIBHB). Regrettably, the original document was accidentally lost. Photo evidence exists.]

BILL WALSH • Three-time victorious Super Bowl Coach • San Francisco 49ers • NFL Hall of Fame • [Also coached the Stanford University Cardinal.] Signed informally at a San Francisco Schools Sports benefit luncheon held at Fort Mason, c.1990

ALICE LOUISE WATERS • Celebrity Chef, Author, & Founder: Chez Panisse Restaurant, Berkeley, California. Pioneer of the *Farm-to-Table* & *Edible Schoolyard* movements. • Signed 2017 November 16th, after her local book signing at First Congregational Church of Berkeley

DENNIS WEAVER • Actor, Environmentalist. Signed at the *Whole Life Expo* in San Francisco, c. 1986

BOBBY WEIR • Singer and former member of *The Grateful Dead* • Signed backstage at *The Warfield Theatre* in San Francisco, late 1980s or 1990

JOHNNY WEISSMULLER, JR. • Actor and longshoreman • Legacy Advisor to the STAR ALLIANCE Co-Founders • Signed during *The Whole Life Expo* in San Francisco, 1986

NANCY WILSON • Jazz Singer • Signed at the historic *Fairmont Hotel* in San Francisco, late 1980s

YANNI • Musician • Signed 2003/05/09 at the coliseum *Arena in Oakland*, California

FURTHER EXPLANATORY NOTES & DISCLAIMER

Ideals are, by definition, *ideas* of perfection. Holistic good will and peace ideals — understood as principles, or natural laws of healthy, sustainable relationships at every level — may generally be considered "perfect" in their individual "star" status as pure *Points of Value*.

These ideal principles are the prime stars of the STAR ALLIANCE. We also hold that *Everyone Can Be a Star*TM — to the extent they try their best to practice all the declared ideals, applied in good balance and proportion to each practical life situation.

That said, no human being is, or should be expected to be, "perfect" in all regards, and certainly at all times!

Accordingly: On behalf of the STAR ALLIANCE organization, our historic signers, and perhaps most of all for Founding President, chief "Integrative Author," editor, and Citizen Philosopher-in-Service, I/we disclaim any unintentionally implied status of perfection for the documents, for ourselves, or for the professional and personal lives and actions of any signer!

The organization deeply appreciates the support of all the VIP celebrity stars who have had the opportunity — and over the years, taken it when they had an opportunity, often without much preparation — to endorse our positive educational writings and projects.

Our quest has been to assemble a body of credible social ideals that we feel — again, taken together and applied with balance, proportion, and wisdom — will hold up favorably to the many difficult tests life presents.

Certainly there is an element of faith here, but it is not a religious faith in the conventional sense. We do not take unprovable positions on "the right way" to name and approach God, or "the gods," or the lack thereof, in either case, or theories of the afterlife. It is a reasoned faith: that if both or all sides of a conflict here on Earth or sky will make a commitment — and do their best — patiently to practice our declared civic principles for peace, in sum: Good will, honesty, integrity, communication, cooperation, and celebration for creativity, common goals (including successful conflict resolution) — along with all the other related values we declare — the principles will tend to work. Something better will tend to evolve.

We invite scientific investigation to prove this premise, and related results of applying it.

We have attempted to derive the values we declare from common sense, direct observation, reasoning, and experience. We invite constructive criticism and feedback from any quarter to improve the set. Even straight-out criticism is welcome, because it gives us something to work with — either to improve the documents when feasible or, where appropriate: To improve our readiness to defend them constructively.

In practical application, amidst the natural diversity and complexities of life, there will always be shades of choice, style, execution, viewpoint, and judgment in arguing and approaching right and wrong. Actors, elements, and situations are always viewed and experienced from different angles, perspectives, contexts, and times. (Please see also our "Public Warnings.")

In the tradition of the great philosopher, *Immanuel Kant*, perhaps only a pure Good Will — or intention for good — can be said to be good without exception.

What is critical to effect more good at this critical time in world history is the exposure and sincere commitment of more and more citizens of the world to the overall spirit of cherishing good will and integrity, and to the entire body of *Civic Good Will Wisdom Values* we can declare.

With best efforts: Each person in the world, born a citizen of the universe, may qualify to become, to be, to act, and in legacy always to remain: a bright shining *Star Citizen* — a lasting *Star of Peace* for our world.
