- 3. Recall clinical trial data regarding novel and developmental treatment approaches in diabetes management, including GLP-1/GIP receptor agonists
- 4. Strategize mitigation of disparities due to inequalities in diabetes care
- 5. Select appropriate pharmacotherapy to intensify treatment where appropriate, based on patient presentation
