



2026 Quarter Midget Specifications

- USAC rules, suspensions, etc. will be followed unless stated otherwise in this rule sheet or at the handler's meeting.
- Fuel will be 87 octane. No additives allowed to the fuel.
- Weights: JUNIOR HONDA - 265# / SENIOR HONDA - 290# / HEAVY HONDA - 340# / ANIMAL 300# (no plate) / LIGHT 160 - 290# / HEAVY 160 - 340#
- No body panel can be higher than 25 inches. This will be measured from the ground up. All cars must look like a quarter midget.
- Rim widths: left side 4 3/4" to 6", right front 5 3/4" to 6 1/2", right rear 7 1/2" to 10".
- All four tires must be slicks.
- All tires must be Hoosier branded. Right side tires are limited to Hoosier NY1. Compound number must be easily visible to be checked at scales.
- Nothing can be put on tires. That means not even washing them. You can use a heat gun or a tire grinder wheel (no wire grinders) to remove tire pick up. A tarp must be used to keep the rubber off the floor and your area must be cleaned before you leave.
- Tires from your car, or your pit area may no be taken outside and brought back into the building.
- No air deflectors leading to the carburetor.
- Maximum 36" on rear tires from center to center.
- No fuel is allowed in the building. Must be stored outside. All fueling must be done outside.
- Once you enter the quarter midget pit area, and any time after that, your car may be inspected or teched. Not allowing us to look at your car will be an automatic DQ for the event.
- Scoring will be done by Marion Ohio Coliseum Racing Series officials. All results will be posted.
- There will be 2 rounds of practice, 2 rounds of heat races. The lowest pill draw will start up front in the first heat and then all draw numbers will be staggered if more than one heat per round. The second round heat line-up will be an invert of the first round heat. Points will be awarded by finishing position to determine the feature line-up.
- Heat races will be 8 laps and the features will be 15 laps, unless otherwise announced. All races will be on a timed curfew, TBA.
- The top 3 from each heat must cross the scales.
- The tech director will advise what he is checking.
- Make sure you pick up your scoring number prior to your pill draw/registration and place it in accordance with instructions from the officials. Line-ups will be posted by your scoring number, and you will be announced to the crowd by your scoring number.
- Schedule and order of events will be posted on the board by the pit steward.
- Only designated handlers will be allowed in the infield unless otherwise announced.
- Do not approach any Marion Ohio Coliseum Racing official or tech director with an attitude. It will not be tolerated.
- Not following any of these rules and procedures or causing a disruption of the program may lead to a DQ and a ban from future Marion Ohio Coliseum Racing events.
- This is going to be a busy event, with a tight schedule. The race director will not wait for anyone. You must be ready to go when your event is called up.
- ONLY electric heaters are allowed inside the pit building, but the building does have heat.
- If you use an extension cord that runs across a walkway, it must be completely taped down, and then removed upon completion of the event. WHEN YOU LEAVE - CLEAN YOUR PIT AREA AND LEAVE IT THE WAY YOU FOUND IT.
- Do not forget that the Kenny Reece Classic is about having fun and showcasing quarter midget racing. It takes a lot of time and money on your part to do this, so let's enjoy the time with the kids.
