

Blue Ridge Cowboy Church Building Use

1. **If** you are an active member of the church, and have been for a minimum of one year, you may use the church facilities.
2. **DATES** for using church facilities for your birthday, anniversary, shower, family get-together, (no personal parties for business' such as paparazzi, or similar events), must be scheduled through the Church Office. The church calendar is on a first-come basis. So, it's important that you get on the calendar as soon as possible. This will give your event priority.
3. **You** must bring your own supplies, (plates, cups, ware, etc...)
4. **USE FEE** Fees must be paid at the time of your reservation of the event.
 - a. \$50 up to 29 people
 - b. \$100 for 30 or more people
5. **CLEAN-UP** Everyone who uses any of the church facilities is responsible for clean up and restoration of those areas used. The church does not provide this service.
 - a. Sanctuary - putting furniture back in place, Sweeping then Mop floors, removing ALL personal decorations, and restoring everything to its place as it was.
 - b. All tables folded and returned, mopping, and setting up chairs for Sunday morning. Someone will instruct you further on this plan.
 - c. Kitchen - clean kitchen and any items used thoroughly, sweep and mop floor.
 - d. Bathrooms- inspected and cleaned
 - e. **Carry off** all trash with you.
 - f. Turn out lights and **close** all doors.
6. **HEAT, AIR** - These are preset and cannot be altered.

GENERAL POLICIES -

- a. The Church decorations that are in place shall not be removed or altered. (Holidays or any other time)
- b. No one is allowed on the stage area of the sanctuary
- c. No alcohol or drugs are allowed in the church or on the church grounds. Smoking allowed outside only.
- d. Please do not use tape, staples or tacks on painted surfaces. No tape, nails or screws on wood surfaces.
- e. No rice, birdseed, confetti, or any other material may be thrown indoors.
- f. The bay door shall not be used.
- g. Parking only in gravel designated areas.
