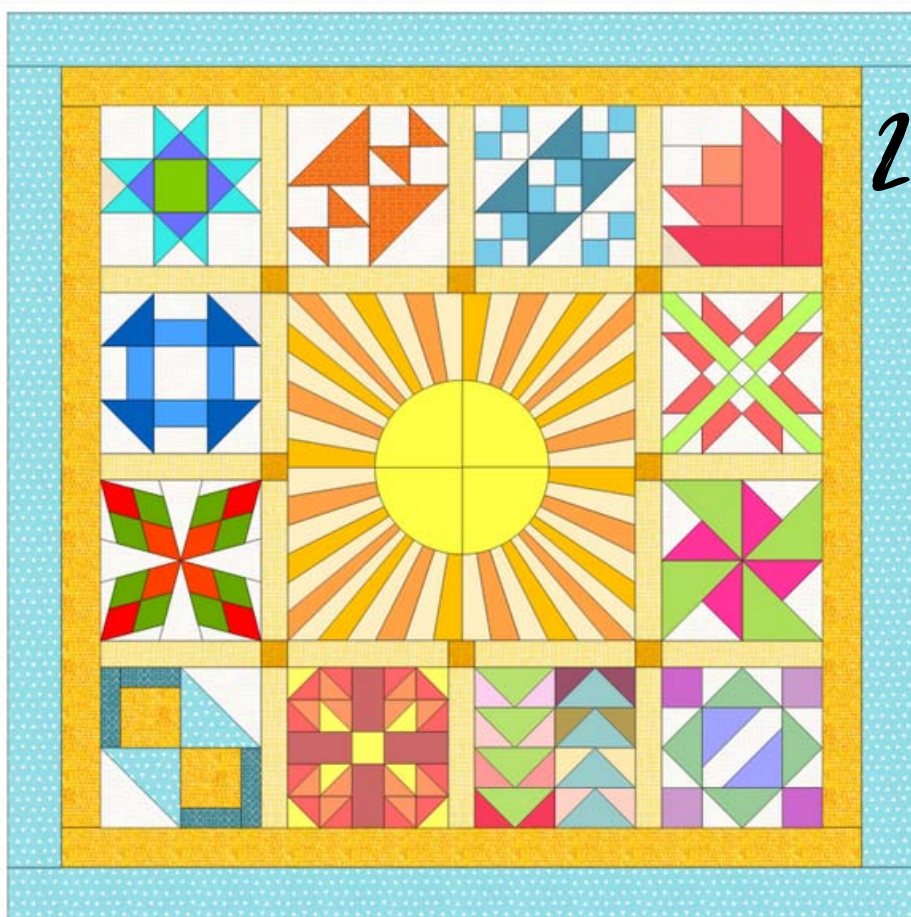

April Class — Hawaiian Applique with Virginia Schrenker

There is a deep history of Hawaiian Applique. It is said that "some Hawaiian women laid some fabric on the grass to dry. They noticed a shadow from the branches of the breadfruit tree on the fabric. The Hawaiian women then cut out the shadowy design and laid it onto another fabric and appliqued and quilted. Thus, the birth of the first Hawaiian quilt. This technique quickly found its way through the islands."

We are lucky to have someone within our guild to show and teach us techniques from afar. Make plans to join the class and learn something new with the rest of us!
