

1. What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text only files saved on your smartphone, tablet, or computer when you visit a website. They are used to help recognise you when you revisit a website and remember your preferences. You can find out more about Cookies by visiting the Wikipedia article [here](#)

2. How and why do we use Cookies?

We use cookies to collect and store basic information about your visit to our website as follows.

- When you visit our site for the first time we ask you to either accept or decline cookies.
- If you accept then a cookie will be placed in your browser to remember your choice
 - You can remove this cookie at any time by following your browser providers instructions on how to do this. Here for example are the instructions when using [Chrome](#)
- We use cookies to improve the experience based the device you are using e.g. smartphone.
- We use cookies to gain a better understanding on visits to our website.
- The data we collect is the number of times a visitor visits our website.
- This data is then presented in a bar chart on the Pyrige Limited specific godaddy dashboard.
 - Only Pyrige Limited employees have access to this information.

3. How you can opt out of Cookies being placed on your device

You can decide to opt out of Cookies by declining Cookies by clicking the decline button in the pop-up window when you first visit our website.
