**It is very important to identify the needs and demographics of the person you are trying to help.**

**Ask as many questions as possible.**

## **Important Questions to Ask**

When was your last meal?

Are you single or married?

Do you have children?

Have you applied for county assistance?

Have you been treated by a Doctor for any mental illnesses?

Do you struggle from or have you ever struggled with alcohol or substance abuse?

Do you have any family that would be willing to help? Can we contact them?

Do you have a place to stay tonight? How long can you stay there?

Do you have an income?

Do you have any felonies?

If they have children: Ask “Have you applied for the one-time homeless assistance through the County of Riverside?” (See pages 6 & 7 for program details.)

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## Current Programs:

- **Shared and Homeless Prevention Housing** with 260 beds in multiple four-plex units, apartments and homes to assist families, single mothers, single men and women, averaging 220 to 260 daily including 60 – 70 children.
- **Local Emergency Shelter** provides year-round overnight shelter to meet the needs of hundreds of clients annually. We provide food, shelter and other essential needs, along with comprehensive case management.
- **Police Response Program** responds 24/7 to calls from local police departments to assist in homeless situations including domestic violence victims.
- **Community Volunteer Program** simply fill out an application online or call the office for more ways to get involved in these areas: Meal Providers, Fundraising, Administration Assistance, Case Managers, Mentors, Thrift Store.
- **Direct Emergency Assistance** emergency housing, transportation assistance, food, clothing, hygiene, and other emergency needs.
- **Resource Referral Center** respond to hundreds of calls monthly to provide appropriate resources for any given situation. Project T.O.U.C.H. partners with multiple agencies such as Social Services, Drug and Alcohol Rehab programs, Mental Health Services, other Homeless Prevention Programs, and community outreach programs. See our website for a comprehensive resource book updated annually.
- **Work Training Program** through our *Divine Discount & Thrift Store*. In this retail environment, clients are able to learn new skills, fulfill their required community service, work on responsibilities and commitment.

## **Riverside County**

### **One Time Homeless Assistance**

The County of Riverside offers to those who qualify, **(they must have dependents and be eligible for cash aid)** a Homeless Assistance program which provides a voucher for up to 16 days at a local hotel/motel in their area. The county will also issue a voucher for permanent housing which will cover last month and Security Deposit up to 80% of their cash aid. They must not have anywhere else to go, or any other resources in order to qualify for the voucher\*.

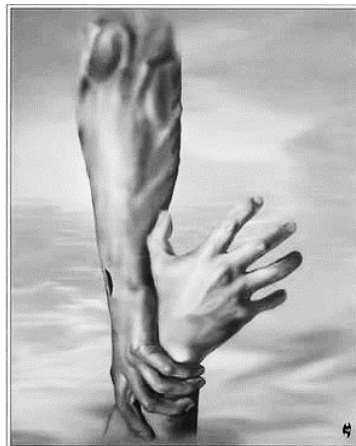
