BARIATRIC GASTRIC SLEEVE

This procedure can remove up to 80% of the stomach. The idea is to create a long "tube" like stomach, also known as "vertical sleeve gastrectomy"
What is the procedure like?
The surgery is done laparoscopically and takes between 60 to 90 minutes to complete.

The surgeon will apply 2 to 5 minor incisions in the abdominal area where the laparoscope will be introduced to view the internal region during the surgery.

IS THIS A GOOD OPTION FOR ME?

The gastric sleeve is the first choice for individuals with obesity (BMI of 50% or more) whom have tried alternate methods to lose weight such as diet and exercise with no success.

Individuals with a BMI of 30 to 40 percent may also be eligible for this procedure if they suffer fromhealth conditions such as, high blood pressure, diabetes, sleep apnea and metabolic syndrome

START OF THE PROCESS



Intro to the preparation 7 day diet prior to the surgery intro to the hospitalization day 1: admission to the hospital, lab work and surgery day 2: recuperation, rest and fluids day 3: drinks, X-rays, medication prescribed and hospital discharged Folfow up consultation in case its necessary
