Comal County Fireworks Restriction

Due to extreme drought conditions, Comal County is restricting the use of certain fireworks.

Comal County Commissioners adopted an order that bans "skyrockets with sticks" or "missiles with fins" in unincorporated areas of Comal County. The order went into effect June 24th and remains in effect until the Texas Forest Service determines drought conditions no longer exist in Comal County.

A violation of the order is considered a Class C misdemeanor.



Landa Park Fireworks Display

The annual Fourth of July Fireworks Spectacular returns to the skies over Landa Park this Independence Day, starting at approximately 9:15pm on Monday, July 4th, 2022, and long-time partner H-E-B is returning as a sponsor for this year's event.

The fireworks are fired over Landa Lake and are viewable throughout Landa Park, the Landa Park Golf Course at Comal Springs, and the Fredericksburg Baseball Fields. (Please note that seating on the golf course begins at 6pm and the putting greens are off limits.) Additionally, the fireworks can be seen in several other places around the city, including Fischer Park.



Fireworks Safety

- Read all labels before using fireworks – don't assume you know how it is going to behave when ignited
- Always have a responsible adult designated as the "firework lighter" – who is not consuming alcohol or other substances that would impair balance or judgement when using or igniting fireworks
- Ensure that others nearby are aware of plans to ignite fireworks and away from trees, shelters, or shrubbery
- Wear protective eyewear
- Keep a bucket of water or a hose nearby for unexpected incidents, soaking spent fireworks before discarding
- Supervise children and teens near fireworks
- NEVER relight a dud firework and only attempt to light one at a time
- NEVER lean over a firework when lighting or after lit (keep head and face away)
- NEVER hold onto a lit firework
- Dispose all fireworks properly by allowing used fireworks to soak in water for several hours before discarding
- Bonus! Keep your pets comfy and free from their own injury by checking to see if you can leave your hand on pavement/asphalt for at least 10 seconds. If not, the ground is too hot for your furry friend's paw pads.
