Due to regulatory restrictions, we cannot accept the following items:

Paint, solvents, thinners, oils, oil rags, oil filters, fuel, fuel tanks, fuel cans, refrigerators, air conditioners, freon cans, acids, fluorescent bulbs, propane bottles, welding gas bottles, herbicides, pesticides, radioactive materials, tires, batteries, any electronics containing built in batteries.

The Changing Weather

It is turning cooler and we have had a little rain, but we are still currently under a burn ban. Not only is the ground saturation much dryer than normal, but the high winds that come with the season would make it much more difficult to contain any fires that get out of control.

ALWAYS check with the Fire Marshal for the status of any burn ban before starting an outdoor burn.
