Halloween Safety Tips

Halloween is coming and the little ghosts and goblins will be out and about. If you are giving out candy or treats at your home, please be sure to turn on the outside lights so parents will know you want visitors.

If you are a parent, follow these simple steps to help keep the little goblins safe:

- An adult should accompany young children on the neighborhood rounds.
- If your older children are going alone, plan & review a route acceptable to you.
- Agree on a specific time children should return home.
- Teach your children never to enter a stranger's home or car.
- Instruct children to travel only in familiar, well-lit areas and stick with their friends.
- Tell your children not to eat any treats until they return home, and take care to avoid any food allergies.
- Children and adults are reminded to put electronic devices down, keep heads up and walk, don't run, across the street.
- If children are allowed out after dark, fasten reflective tape to their costumes and bags, or give them glow sticks.
- Watch for vehicle traffic, they may not be able to see you or your children!
