
CLIMATE

In a typical year, Farmer City, Illinois temperatures fall below 50F° for 152 days per year. Annual precipitation in Farmer City is typically 37.9 inches per year (moderate in the US) and snow covers the ground 46 days per year or 12.6% of the year (moderate in the US). It may be helpful to understand the yearly precipitation by imagining 7 straight days of moderate rain per year. The humidity in Farmer City, Illinois is below 60% for approximately 116.4 days or 31.9% of the year.

COST OF LIVING

Farmer City is a city in De Witt County, Illinois, with a population of 1,926. The total cost of housing, food, child care, transportation, health care, taxes, and other necessities for a single adult in Farmer City is \$36,006 a year — less than the annual cost of living for Illinois of \$37,387 and less than the national figure of \$38,433.

In Farmer City, the median home value is \$116,900, less than the national median home value of \$204,900.




DEMOGRAPHICS

As of the 2020 census[3] there were 1,828 people, 848 households, and 563 families residing in the city. The population density was 748.26 inhabitants per square mile. There were 884 housing units at an average density of 361.85 per square mile. The racial makeup of the city was 93.98% White, 0.88% African American, 0.05% Native American, 0.11% Asian, 0.11% Pacific Islander, 0.33% from other races, and 4.54% from two or more races. Hispanic or Latino of any race were 2.02% of the population.



THINGS TO DO AROUND FARMER CITY

CLINTON LAKE

7251 RANGER ROAD, DEWITT, ILLINOIS

Recreational opportunities abound at the 9,300-acre site. Clinton Lake is the cooling lake for the Exelon Power Station, and the IDNR manages recreation on the lake and surrounding lands.

The 4,900-acre lake and outstanding fishing are the primary draws, with accessible boat launches at the Mascoutin and West Side Access Areas, a fishing pier at the Spillway Access Area, and bank fishing at Valley Mill. From crappie to catfish to bass and walleye - anglers love Clinton Lake.



Clinton is a busy boating lake for motorboats big and small, and sail boating is also popular. A beautiful, 1,000-foot sand beach awaits swimmers and sunbathers, open Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend.

Hiking trails throughout the site and along the lake shoreline range from easy to moderate in difficulty. Picnic areas and playgrounds are found throughout the site, while campgrounds feature 17 Class AA campsites, 277 Class A campsites and 14 Class B/S campsites.



WELDON SPRINGS

4734 WELDON SPRINGS RD, CLINTON, ILLINOIS

Located just southeast of Clinton in DeWitt County, Weldon Springs State Park is a 550-acre park for all seasons. Weldon Springs' recreational agenda is among the most comprehensive in the state park system, offering recreational opportunities year-round. During the milder seasons, you are invited to fish, boat, picnic, camp, hike, and view wildlife. Or, you might want to pitch horseshoes at the park's tournament-quality horseshoe pits. When the snow flies, hardier outdoors persons not only continue many of the warmer weather pursuits, but add sledding and tobogganing on a one-eighth mile hill, ice fishing and cross-country skiing to the itinerary of their visit.

According to the 2020 Census, There are 897 housing units in Farmer City, and the median year in which these properties were built is 1963. Of the 789 occupied housing units in Farmer City, 85.3% are owner-occupied, while 14.7% have renters living in them.

Meanwhile, properties bought with mortgages account for 52.9% of the units, and the median value of a home with a mortgage is \$127,300. In general, housing costs reach \$769 per month in Farmer City.

NEW APARTMENTS

A brand new apartment complex is set to be built on the north side of Interstate 74 starting in 2024. Two high end 8 unit apartment buildings are planned for development in this area, so stay tuned!
