Hyacinths

1. 1 boom, either cut or potted, any colour

Daffodils

2. Specimen bloom – Trumpet, Large Cup, Small Cup or Multi Headed
3. 3 Blooms – Trumpet, one or more varieties
4. 3 Blooms – Large or Small Cup, one or more varieties
5. 3 Stems – Multi Headed, one or more varieties
6. 1 Bloom – best perfumed

Tulips

7. Specimen Bloom – any variety
8. 3 Blooms – one or more varieties

Camellias

9. 1 Specimen bloom – single/semi double/double

Hellebores

10. 3 Stems of Hellebores – single or double, one or more varieties

Shrubs

11. 3 Sprays of flowering shrub or tree, one or more varieties
12. 3 Sprays of non-flowering shrubs or trees, one or more varieties

Odd one out

13. Something in bloom out of season

Flora art

14. A posy from your garden, can include flowers, foliage, and herbs – to fit inside 15x15cm board

In your own container, no floral foam to be used
