Refresh Morning Dew Disciple Lessons

1 What

The purpose of the commandment is to “love one another,” which embodies the presence and power of the ONE God. The light shines as His power flows through a pure heart, a clear conscience, and sincere faith. By finding the joy of living sacrifice and learning to live in Christ, we bud in our lives and bear fruits, building testimonies of the mighty name of Jesus Christ. For those in Christ, He is now with you.

2 Why

To make His enemy a footstool
Enjoying abundant life

Joyful

These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full. (John 15:11)

Plentiful

But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. (Matthew 6:33)

Fruitful

If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples. (John 15:7-8)

Successful

Now Abraham was old, well advanced in years. And the Lord had blessed Abraham in all things. (Genesis 24:1)

Peaceful

The blessing of the Lord makes rich, and he adds no sorrow with it. (Proverb 10:22)
All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him. Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will

give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. (Matthew 11:27-30)

Victorious and fruitful: walking with the risen Lord (Christ's love)

Not by emotion, but by the spirit

And you were dead in the trespasses and sins in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience—among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 2:1-7)

Obey not, Obey

Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure. (Philippians 2:12-13)

4 Fear of the Lord (FOL)

4.1 Fact of FOL

Beginning of Knowledge

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction. (Proverbs 1:7)

The Lord by wisdom founded the earth;
By understanding he established the heavens;
by his knowledge the deeps broke open,
and the clouds drop down the dew.
(Proverbs 3:19-20)

“The Lord possessed me at the beginning of his work, the first of his acts of old. Ages ago I was set up, at the first, before the beginning of the earth. When there were no depths I was brought forth, when there were no springs abounding with water. Before the mountains had been shaped, before the hills, I was brought forth, before he had made the earth with its fields, or the first of the dust of the world.

When he established the heavens, I was there; when he drew a circle on the face of the deep, when he made firm the skies above, when he established the fountains of the deep, when he assigned to the sea its limit, so that the waters might not transgress his command, when he marked out the foundations of the earth, then I was beside him, like a master workman, and I

was daily his delight, rejoicing before him
 always, rejoicing in his inhabited world
 and delighting in the children of man.
 (Proverbs 8:22-31)

My hand laid the foundation of the earth,
 and my right hand spread out the heavens;
 when I call to them, they stand forth
 together. (Isaiah 48:13)

I, I am he who comforts you; who are you

Beginning of Wisdom

4.2 How to find FOL**Seek, ask, and receive the word of God**

My son, if you receive my words,
And treasure my commands within you,
So that you incline your ear to wisdom,
And apply your heart to understanding;
Yes, if you cry out for discernment,
And lift up your voice for understanding,
If you seek her as silver,
And search for her as for hidden treasures;
Then you will understand the fear of the LORD,
And find the knowledge of God. (Proverbs 2:1-5)

Call to Me, and I will answer you and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.' (Jeremiah 33:3)

Being blessed

Praise the LORD!
Blessed is the Man who fears the LORD,
Who delights greatly in His commandments.
(Psalm 112:1)

Chose to walk in the right path

Blessed is the Man
Who walks not in the counsel of the
ungodly,
Nor stands in the path of sinners,
Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;
But his delight is in the law of the LORD,
And in His law, he meditates day and night.
He shall be like a tree
Planted by the rivers of water,
That brings forth its fruit in its season,
Whose leaf also shall not wither;
And whatever he does shall prosper. (Psalm
1:1-3)

Confidence of life

The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life,
To turn one away from the snares of death.
(Proverbs 14:27)

Anointing and teaching by the Spirit

Turn at my rebuke;
 Surely I will pour out my spirit on you;
 I will make my words known to you.
 (Proverbs 1:23)

Safety and security

But whoever listens to me will dwell safely,
 And will be secure, without fear of evil.”
 (Proverbs 1:33)

Bless the LORD, O my soul,
 And forget not all His benefits:

 So that your youth is renewed like the eagle.

Abundant life

The thief does not come except to steal and
 kill, and destroy. I have come that they may
 have life and that they may have it more
 abundantly. (John 10:10)

From everlasting to everlasting

The loving devotion of the LORD
 extends to those who fear Him,
 and His righteousness to their children’s
 children—
 to those who keep His covenant
 and remember to obey His precepts.

The LORD has established His throne in heaven,
and His kingdom rules over all. (Psalm 103:17-19)

Humility and the fear of the LORD are riches, honor, and life. (Proverbs 22:4)

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. Therefore, do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its things. Sufficient for the day is its trouble. (Matthew 6:33-34)

4.4 The penalty of not FOL

Attitude: “Wilderness mentality,” do not know who they are, and blame others; “Slum mentality” always want more

Whoever loves discipline loves knowledge, but he who hates correction is stupid. (Proverbs 12:1)

Arrogance leads only to strife,

But wisdom is with the well-advised. (Proverbs 13:10)

No protection, rejected God’s defense in an evil time

Because you refused my call,
and no one took my outstretched hand,
because you neglected all my counsel,
and wanted none of my corrections,
in turn, I will mock your calamity;
I will sneer when terror strikes you,

when your dread comes like a storm,
 and your destruction like a whirlwind,
 when distress and anguish overwhelm you.
 (Proverbs 1:24-27)

No answer from God

Then they will call on me, but I will not answer;
 they will earnestly seek me, but will not find me. (Proverbs 1:28)

Invites destruction

For the turning away of the simple will slay them,
 And the complacency of fools will destroy them;
 But whoever listens to me will dwell safely,
 And will be secure, without fear of evil."
 (Proverbs 1:32-33)

4.5 What is doing FOL

Hate evil

I, wisdom, dwell together with prudence,
 and I find knowledge and discretion.
 To fear the LORD is to hate evil;
 I hate arrogant pride, evil conduct, and
 perverse speech. (Proverbs 8:12-13)

Depart from evil

By loving devotion and faithfulness,
 iniquity is atoned for,
 and by the fear of the LORD, one turns
 aside from evil. (Proverbs 16:6)

Overcome evil

They have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony.

And they did not love their lives to shy away from death. (Revelation 12:11)

Inviting Blessings

“Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe all His commandments which I command you today, that the LORD your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you because you obey the voice of the LORD your God:

“Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the country.

“Blessed shall be the fruit of your body, the produce of your ground and the increase of your herds, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks. (Deuteronomy 28:1-4)

Walking in Favor

My son, do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments; for they will add length to your days, years and peace to your life.

Never let loving devotion or faithfulness leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. Then you will find favor and high regard

in the sight of God and Man.

Trust in the LORD with all your heart,

Overcome the world in Christ

Free from bondage

From the days of John the Baptist until now,
the kingdom of heaven has been subjected
to violence, and violent people have been
raiding it. (Matthew 11:12)

Know the joy of Living sacrifice

Therefore I urge you, brothers, on account
of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as
living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God,
which is your spiritual service of worship
(Romans 12:1)

Attaining Morning Dew life Characters

Since that time, He waits for His enemies to be made a footstool for His feet because by a single offering He has made perfect for all time those who are being sanctified. (Hebrews 10:13-14)

5 What God is doing today

He is the authority of the universe

He has all under His power

And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation, and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on the earth."

Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!"

And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea, and all that is in them, saying, "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever!" (Revelation 5:9-13)

1) He is upholding all things

Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. (Hebrews 1:1-3)

I form light and create darkness;
I make well-being and create calamity;
I am the Lord, who does all these things.
(Isaiah 45:7)

The king's heart is a stream of water in the hand of the Lord; he turns it wherever he will. (Proverbs 21:1)

2) He is calling and qualifying His disciples

Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. (Hebrews 10:19-22)

Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much

fruit. Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. If anyone serves me, he must follow me; and where I am, there will my servant be also. If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him. (John 12:24-26)
 See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are. The reason why the world does not know us is that it did not know him. (1 John 3:1)

3) He gives Words to Disciple for Works

He gives power to the faint,
 and to him who has no might he increases strength.

Even youths shall faint and be weary,
 and young men shall fall exhausted;
 but they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength;
 they shall mount up with wings like eagles;
 they shall run and not be weary;
 they shall walk and not faint. (Isaiah 40:29-31)

fear not, for I am with you;
 be not dismayed, for I am your God;
 I will strengthen you, I will help you,
 I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. (Isaiah 41:10)

I have blotted out your transgressions like a cloud and your sins like mist; return to me, for I have redeemed you. (Isaiah 44:22)

By myself I have sworn;
 from my mouth has gone out in righteousness

a word that shall not return:
 'To me every knee shall bow,
 every tongue shall swear allegiance.'
 (Isaiah 45:23)

4) He makes direction and decision

The heart of man plans his way,
 but the Lord establishes his steps.
 (Proverbs 16:9/ 16:33)

5) He makes His enemies His footstool

The Lord says to my Lord:
 "Sit at my right hand,
 until I make your enemies your footstool."
 (Psalm 110:1)

Your kingdom come,
 your will be done,
 on earth as it is in heaven.
 Give us this day our daily bread, (Matthew
 6:10-11)

Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and
 you will find; knock, and it will be opened
 to you. For everyone who asks receives, and
 the one who seeks finds, and to the one
 who knocks it will be opened. (Matthew
 7:7-8)

And Jesus came and said to them, "All
 authority in heaven and on earth has been
 given to me. Go therefore and make
 disciples of all nations, baptizing them in
 the name of the Father and of the Son and
 of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe
 all that I have commanded you. And behold,

I am with you always, to the end of the age.”
(Matthew 28:18-20)

But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet. (Hebrews 10:12-13)

6) He answers the disciple’s prayer

If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it. “If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you. (John 14:14-16)

7) He makes the testimony of disciples

And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death. (Revelation 12:11)

From his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations, and he will rule them with a rod of iron. He will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty. (Revelation 19:11-16)

8) He saves all whose name is written

I said to him, “Sir, you know.” And he said to me, “These are the ones coming out of the great tribulation. They have washed

their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. (Revelation 7:14)

Lest you be wise in your own sight, I do not want you to be unaware of this mystery, brothers: a partial hardening has come upon Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. (Romans 11:25)

9) He is preparing our eternal dwelling

In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? (John 14:2)

Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away."

And he who was seated on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." Also he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true." (Revelation 21:1-5)

And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. (Revelation 21:3)

6 You should know

- 1) What is eternal and why

Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away. (Matthew 24:35)

- 2) What is eternal operation code

But let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the LORD who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth. For in these things I delight, declares the LORD.” (Jeremiah 9:24)

Then he said to me, “This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the LORD of hosts. (Zechariah 4:6)

- 3) How eternal code works in my life

But the LORD said to Moses, “Put out your hand and catch it by the tail”—so he put out his hand and caught it, and it became a staff in his hand—(Exodus 4:4)

“Behold, his soul is puffed up; it is not upright within him, but the righteous shall live by his faith. (Habakkuk 2:4)

- 4) Works of invisible power

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly. (John 10:10)

Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God. So we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him. (1 John 4:15-16)

If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it. (John 14:14)

And Jesus said to him, “‘If you can’t! All things are possible for one who believes.” (Mark 9:23)

- 5) How to attain that I desire in Christ; Learn and practice how to think in the Word

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. (Philippians 4:8)

But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. (Matthew 6:33)

“If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it

neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.

“I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you. Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him.” Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, “Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself to us, and not to the world?” Jesus answered him, “If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father’s who sent me. (John 14:15-24)

As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. [10] If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father’s commandments and abide in his love. [11] These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.

“This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends. You are my

friends if you do what I command you. No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you. You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you. These things I command you, so that you will love one another. (John 15:9-17)

7 Jesus reign

1) God's unchanging operation principle

By Loving-kindness, Justice, and Righteousness

The LORD reigns, let the earth rejoice;
let the many coastlands be glad!
Clouds and thick darkness are all around
him; righteousness and justice are the
foundation of his throne. (Psalm 97:1-2)

Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches, but let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the LORD who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth. For in these things I delight, declares the LORD" (Jeremiah 9:23-24)

By unchanging character

So when God desired to show more convincingly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeable character of his purpose, he guaranteed it with an oath, so that by two unchangeable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to hold fast to the hope set before us. (Hebrews 6:17-18)

By His Word

Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs. (Hebrew 1:1-4)

Through Christ

Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice,

“Worthy is the Lamb who was slain,

to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!”

And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea, and all that is in them, saying,

“To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever!”

If You can?" echoed Jesus. "All things are possible to him who believes!" (Mark 9:23)

Attitude

* Always prepare all you do to be acceptable to the Lord: worship, sacrifice, dedication. Remind that opens gates of blessing.

By humility and the fear of the Lord
Are riches and honor and life. (Proverbs 22:4)

Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to death—even death on a cross. (Philippians 2:5-8)

Therefore I urge you, brothers, on account of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God,

Availability

* Remind that He is always available to you when you seek and come to Him in FAITH: help, guide, protect, provide, counsel, direct, and answer.

The LORD said to my Lord: "Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet." The LORD extends Your mighty scepter from Zion: "Rule amid Your enemies." Your people shall be willing on Your day of battle. Arrayed in holy splendor, from the womb of the dawn to You belongs the dew of Your youth. (Psalm 110:1-3)

If you love Me, you will keep My commandments. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Advocate to be with you forever—the Spirit of truth. The world cannot receive Him because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. But you do know Him, for He abides with you and will be in you (John 14:15-17)

Join me in suffering, like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. A soldier refrains from entangling himself in civilian affairs to please the one who enlisted him. Likewise, a competitor does not receive the crown unless he competes according to the rules. The hardworking farmer should be the first

Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin but to save those who are eagerly waiting for him. (Hebrews 9:27-28)

4. Abide in the Lord, meditate Words and hear the voice of the Holy Spirit day and night

So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him. As the living Father sent me, and I live because of the Father, so whoever feeds on me, he also will live because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven, not like the bread the fathers ate, and died. Whoever feeds on this bread will live forever." (John 6:53-57)
