INTRODUCTION

“For what has a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul. Alternatively, what shall a man give in exchange for his soul? But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.” (Matthew 16:26)

1. CALL

Sanctify place: pure/holy

Make your gathering place be like a Ramah Naioth/Upper Room/Tyrannus class where you are gathering. (1 Samuel 19:19; Acts 1:13; 19:9)

Invite the Holy Spirit

But the Counselor, Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. (John 14:26)

As for you, the anointing you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about all things and as that anointing is real, not counterfeit—just as it has taught you, remain in him. (1 John 2:27)

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you. (Psalm 32:8)

Let the morning bring me word of your unfailing love, for I have put my trust in you. Show me the way I should go, for to you I entrust my life. (Psalm 143:8)

This is what the LORD says—your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: "I am the LORD your God, who teaches you what is best for you, who directs you in the way you should go. (Isaiah 48:17)

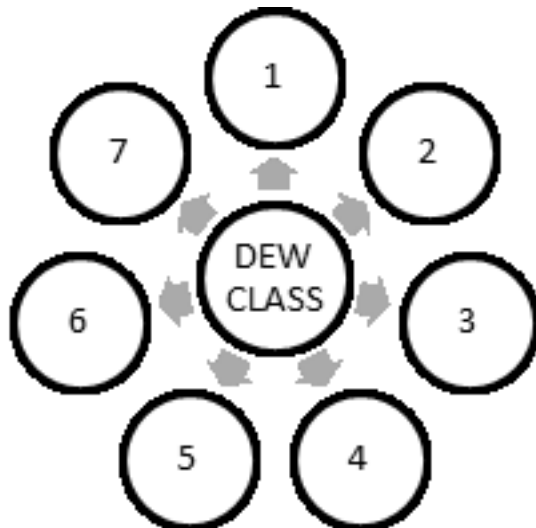
Cry out to God

1.2 CHECKLIST OF MY SPIRIT

- a. Do you believe that He is with you when you call His name?
- b. Do you believe that He will reward you when you come to Him?
- c. Can you ask the Holy Spirit to search your heart?
- d. Did you categorically repent of all that He brought to your mind?
- e. Did you ask the Holy Spirit to teach you?
- f. Are you ready to follow the Holy Spirit?
- g. Would you obey all that He asked of you?

Your faithfulness today will determine if you will take the route of blessings tomorrow. Blessings and gifts are already prepared for you, but cannot be given if the duties and responsibilities of today are not fulfilled.

Understand the importance of ending your day with prayer before retiring to your sleep. The good news is that He is not seeking a perfect person but a broken heart, a contrite spirit.

Remember that it was God, not Moses who led the Israelites in the wilderness. Moses simply obeyed God’s command. Let the Holy Spirit lead you; be an obedient servant. Obey what you know and share what you hear. Learn not from a man, but from the Spirit.

1.3 REWARDS IN HEAVEN

It is written: Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward. If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire. (1 Corinthians 3:12-15)

1.4 PERCEIVE, EYES TO SEE, AND EARS TO HEAR

It is written: Now Moses called all Israel and said to them: "You have seen all that the Lord did before your eyes in the land of Egypt, to Pharaoh and to all his servants and to all his land the great trials which your eyes have seen, the signs, and those great wonders. Yet the Lord has not given you a heart to perceive and eyes to see and ears to hear, to this very day. (Deuteronomy 29:2-4)

[] Do you know what could open your heart?

Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless; (2 Peter 3:13-14)

Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes." (Mark 9:23)

[] Do you believe all things are possible with God?

As He also says in another place: "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek" who, in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear, though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered. And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him. (Hebrews 5:6-9)
