#### A Letter From the Pastor

An unguarded treasure is likely to be taken. As a child, I learned this lesson the hard way. When I was in 5th grade my bicycle was one of my prized possessions. I rode it most days. I always left it parked in the backyard, which was pretty open and visible from most streets. I did not lock it up or secure it in any way. One morning I woke up to find that my bicycle, something I treasured, was gone. I did not properly guard or secure it, and I lost it. Someone had taken it and there was nothing I could do. From then on, I used a chain to lock up my next bicycle. I learned not to be careless with things that I value.

Scripture instructs us to: "Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it." (Proverbs 4:23) We are instructed to guard our hearts as if they are treasures. Your heart is your treasure, and it is also the treasure you present to God. Therefore, it is essential to intentionally guard your heart each and every day. It is too dangerous to let your guard down. Yet I fear we often do.

I suspect the average American Christian does a nominal job at best filling his heart with the righteous things of the Lord and of guarding his heart from corrupting things that damage his faith and soul. We can sometimes have a false sense of security, as if no danger exists. We can become too trusting of our environment and the forces around us. Above guarding our hearts we can prioritize fitting in, not missing out on what others are doing, and indulging in pleasures. We let our guard down because we do not want confrontation or because we want to enjoy the same kind of entertainment as others. When you let your guard down, your heart is just as vulnerable as my bicycle was.

The way to guard your heart is to not only avoid things that would corrupt it, but also by submitting to God's protection by prayer and scripture reading. "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. 7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6-7) May you always guard your heart as a valuable, yet vulnerable, treasure to give to the Lord.




