A Letter From the Pastor

In the story of the Rich Young Man, Jesus responds to his questioning with this invitation, "You still lack one thing. Sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." (Luke 18:22) The Rich Young Ruler then leaves sad because he is very wealthy and is apparently unwilling to part with his many possessions. Sometimes when we read this story, we, too, walk away sad with the Rich Young Ruler because the request to sell all we have is a scary one that we doubt we could do either.

However, the invitation Jesus offers the man, and to us, is not to less but to MORE. That is part of our problem. Like the Rich Young man we value the wrong things. We value stuff that is perishable, here today and gone tomorrow. So, we hear the call of Jesus to sell all as a harsh demand. Yet, Jesus is not calling us to less but to MORE.

Jesus calls us to value what is eternal. He calls us to free ourselves from things that seek to possess us and to pursue treasure in heaven. To accept the invitation to detach from the things of this world to gain treasures in heaven as you follow Jesus is not a life of less but a life of so much MORE. The person who accepts this invitation is far richer than the one who does not.


