A Letter From the Pastor

Is your life in need of an alteration? Does life seem like a bad fit at times? Where can you go for a spiritual alteration? This season of Lent, I invite you to join me at the altar for a spiritual alteration. Together we will seek to be altered at the altar.

When you think of an altar, what thoughts come to mind? Do you think of it as a place of prayer? A place of sacrifice? A place of surrender and transformation? In the Old Testament, altars were places of worship where people brought offerings to God. Each offering was a tangible act of devotion and an expression of submission to God. For us today, the altar is still a place of devotion and submission to God. The altar is the centerpiece of our worship space. It is a sacred space as a place where we meet God and experience His grace. Though we no longer bring animal sacrifices, we come to the altar to lay down our very lives as a living sacrifice to God. The first 2 verses of Romans 12 link transformation with surrender to God. "Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will."

The altar is the place where we bring our hearts to God in worship, confess our sins, and receive His forgiveness. It is where we encounter the power of Christ's sacrifice on the cross. The altar calls us to lay down our burdens, to seek His presence, and to respond to His love with our own. It calls us to surrender and offer our lives to God in worship, gratitude, and service. As we kneel at the altar, whether physically or in our hearts, may we remember that it is not just a place of sacrifice, but also a place of transformation and grace.

For Lent this year we will journey through the devotion book titled "Altar'd: The Transforming Power of Surrender". Our sermon series will follow along with the book. May we all be transformed by surrendering our lives at the altar.
