A Letter From the Pastor

It is the time of year for back to school. The freedom of summer break will come to an end and will be replaced by the rhythm of early mornings, packed schedules, school assignments. Each day comes with new assignments that are intended to further students' education. If the assignments are incomplete or ignored, the student will not be very successful.

As Christians, God assigns us work to do in this world. These assignments come in the form of opportunities to minister to and serve others. Yet, it is difficult to complete an assignment if you are unaware that an assignment exists. If you do not realize that you have been assigned work, then you will not likely do the assigned work. Part of our task each day as Christians is to expect an assignment from God. Since the assignment comes from God, in order to receive the assignment, we need to seek God first. We do this through prayer, reading His Word, and surrendering to our Lord Jesus. We rise each day ready to listen, obey, and be led by the Holy Spirit. It is more difficult to hear God if our focus is on so many other things and our lives are crowded with noise and distractions.

Acts 8 tells us about an assignment from God given to Philip. "Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip, 'Go south to the road—the desert road that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." Philip is led to a place where he meets a high-ranking Ethiopian official reading from Isaiah. Philip initiates a conversation about the scripture and explains the gospel to the man. The man accepts Gospel and is baptized on the spot. We cannot say for sure if Philip woke up that morning with an expectation that he would receive an assignment from God, but I think the odds are pretty good that he did. Those who surrender their lives to God recognize that they have devoted their lives to God's mission. Like a student in class, a player on a football team, or a soldier in war who expects to be given assignments that serve the mission, we should expect to be assigned tasks that advance God's mission. If you are not doing the assignments then you are not helping advance the mission. I encourage you to begin each day seeking to hear from God and receive an assignment that furthers God's mission.






