A Letter From the Pastor

The final words of Jesus before He ascended into heaven assign a mission to His disciples. Jesus said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28:18b-20). Jesus spent 3 years with His disciples preparing them to be disciplemakers. And then as they made disciples, those disciples made more disciples, and the church grew and grew.

Our mission as a church is to make disciples of Jesus Christ. How do we do that? We do that by disciples reaching the point in their faith journey where they become disciple-makers. As you grow in discipleship, it is not intended that you only grow in knowledge, in wisdom, and in righteousness. It is also the goal for you to grow in influence. Maybe God could be calling you to start a new disciple-making opportunity for you and others. If you are unsure about what ways you can be a disciple-maker in our church, I encourage you to pray about it. I would be honored to join you in praying about it if you will let me know.






