The Specific Duties of an Usher Team Leader at The Smith Thomas Convention Center

INTRODUCTION: The associations usher team leaders has an important role in creating a welcoming experience for all who attend any function at the Smith Thomas Convention Center. Each team leader serves as a model of working leadership for their teams to emulate. They are also present to help ensure that our visitors, guest and members have a positive experience under their watch.

ROLE: The usher team leader is part of the Usher Unions leadership team. They report to the Union President through their team contact person (who is also a board member). The team leader will lead their assigned team in a manner that ensures a positive experience for everyone. Each team shall work to fulfill the following tasks when needed at the Smith Thomas Convention Center:

☐ Arrive to serve no later than the time stated on the ushering schedule.
☐ Be in the proper seasonal ushers' uniform.
☐ Assemble as a team for prayer and post assignments.
☐ Be on post before the attendees arrive.
☐ Cover all exterior doors while acting as greeters by passing out literature while providing a warm and sincere welcome.
☐ Sanctuary ushers' will assist with seating, program and report distribution.
☐ <u>Assist with the distribution</u> of session programs, financial and previous meeting reports.
☐ Ensuring that the church has been reset for the next session/service.
☐ Be aware of unions chain of command which is outlined as follows:

The Triune Godhead
The Moderator
The Usher Union Chair
The Union's Executive Board
The Unions Usher Team Leader
The Churches Usher Presidents
The Ushers

RESPONSIBILITIES: The team leader's responsibilities are to equip their team by:

Contacting the Usher Ministry Presidents of each church assigned to their team as soon as possible. Inform them that the 2018
Ushers calendar is posted on the associations webpage (www.eastcedargrove-mba.org) under the Ushers section. Ask them to go
to that site and download multiple copies for their usher team leaders and for themselves.

- ☐ Inform them you are contacting to ask for one ushers to assist in covering the teams.
- ☐ Give them the date, time and location of the teams next service event. Answer any other questions they may have. Should you be asked a question that you are not sure how to answer, call your teams contact person initially or myself as the alternate contact.

The day your team is scheduled to serve: Pre-Service: The team leader will coordinate the duties of the Ushers. ☐ All ushers must be on site no later than 30 minutes before the posted start time of the program or session. ☐ The team leader should assure that any ushers that are serving at the STCC for the first time are comfortable with their role. ☐ Conduct team prayer; conduct roll call, check uniforms, give post assignments, check the restrooms, ask the trustees to replace paper towels and tissue paper if needed. ☐ Be physically on your post no later than fifth teen minutes prior to the events posted start time or as the attendees begin to arrive.	
At least four (4) active ushers are needed in the sanctuary at all times at the Smith Thomas Convention Center: □ These Ushers/Greeters are responsible for having: a) Two ushers at the double doors that lead from the vestibule to the sanctuary. These ushers will be accountable for passing out programs and maintaining control of their doors. They are not to let anyone enter or leave the sanctuary during the following periods: i. When any type prayer is being given. ii. When any type scripture is being read. iii. When any special reading (Resolution of Respect, Meeting Minutes, Reading of ant special documents, etc.). b) One usher at the exterior door to the right side when facing the pulpit. This is the wheelchair access door. Our goal is to place all people with limited mobility in this areas. c) One usher at the table where the secretary sits. This usher will be the primary contact when it is time to pass out any literature (financial reports, meeting minutes, etc.) d) Four reserve ushers will be seated in the last two row of pews. They are to provide relief to the four active ushers that are covering the areas listed in section a, b, and c above.	
As the attendees enter:	
☐ Shake everyone's hand, make eye contact, and greet worshippers as they enter the building. make everyone feel welcomed and at ease.	
☐ Be available to answer questions of anyone needing assistance.	
☐ Give special attention to all guests and try to introduce them to an existing member of the session.	
☐ Make additional considerations for all people with disabilities. Be aware of wheelchair accessibility and safe routes. Know the designated spots for wheelchairs (the right side door where the ramp is located). ☐ Pick up trush and bulleting left behind	
☐ Pick up trash and bulletins left behind.	
☐ Make sure the lobby and worship area are presentable for the next service.	
☐ Both ushers and greeters should be prepared to assist with emergencies and know where emergency support items are located
