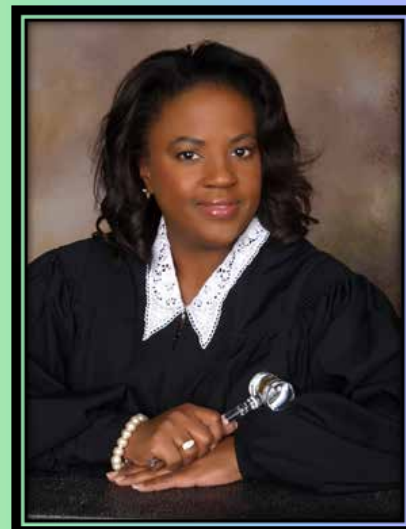

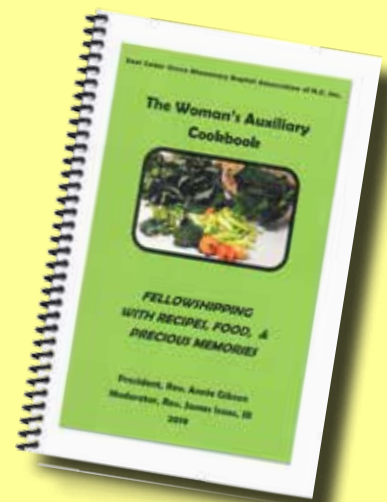

Our Speaker

Judge Carolyn J. Thompson



Minister Carolyn J. Thompson presides as a Superior Court Judge in the Ninth Judicial District. As a minister and judge, she is inspired to educate the church community regarding victims and survivors of domestic abuse. Those who attend our local churches seeking pastoral care and counseling because of abusive relationships often return the same if not re-victimized because of misinformation or void of information. The goal of Abigail's Veil Ministry is to educate and empower the faith community to appropriately address domestic violence. Her dual role offers a unique perspective of the church's decision to respond or its decision to avoid any response in parishioners' "private" issues such as domestic violence.

Prior to becoming a judge, she advocated on behalf of domestic violence victims for over 13 years as a domestic/family law attorney. She includes her childhood exposure to domestic violence and personal relationships as testimonials supporting the urgent call for educating the church community. Admittedly, she too wore the VEIL like so many women in the church.

On November 4, 2008, Judge Thompson was elected as the first female District Court judge to preside in over 15 years. Ten years later, she was appointed by the Governor of North Carolina to serve as a Superior Court Judge. Judge Thompson is also the first female and African American to preside as a Superior Court Judge in 9th Judicial District. Her county seat is Oxford, North Carolina, however, she holds court in all five surrounding counties of Vance, Warren, Franklin, Person and Granville.

She obtained a Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology from Hampton University and a Juris Doctor degree from North Carolina Central University School of Law. She is a licensed and ordained Minister of the Gospel. In May 2007, she completed the Duke University Divinity School's Pastoral Care curriculum, which enables her to volunteer as a hospital chaplain.

In 2008, she founded ABIGAIL'S VEIL to provide domestic violence training for clergy and church leaders. The need to inform clergy became obvious during many years of representing abused women and children. Many of whom stayed in their abusive homes and relationships based on pastoral counseling, church traditions and stigmas promoted within church doctrines. As an advocate for families living free of violence. It is Minister Thompson's prayer that God will grant her wisdom and resources to boldly educate the faith community in addressing and preventing domestic violence.

Throughout her legal and ministerial career, Minister Thompson has served as board member and general member to legal and community-focused organizations, including but not limited to the: Granville County Human Relations Commission (served 3 terms by appointment); Granville County Families Living Violence Free, Inc.; Granville County Judicial Attendance Council (aka, Truancy Court) as a volunteer presiding judge; Granville County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council; Granville and Franklin Counties Ministerial Alliances; Franklin County and Warren County Domestic Violence Task Force; Oxford Chapter of Les Gemme, Incorporated and Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.

Giving all honor to God, Minister Thompson is a recipient of numerous recognitions and certificates of appreciation for her community service. Most recent acknowledgments of her commitment to service include: Certificate of Specialization in Juvenile Court issued by the North Carolina Judicial Department of the Administrative Office of Courts; the 2014 Women of Justice Award for Public Service issued by the North Carolina Lawyers Weekly; the 2015 Power of One award issued by the Women's Economic Equity Project of Henderson, North Carolina; and Candidacy Endorsement by the North Carolina Association of Women Attorneys.

She is blessed to be the wife of a loving husband, 1st Sergeant John E. Thompson, Jr. (Ret. Army) and together they are the parents of a blended family of children, Arthur Jr., Aaron, Cathryn, Brittany and John III and grandchildren, Teaghan, MARRISA, Laicee, and Audrey. Their family's creed is and shall remain, "I can do ALL things through Christ who is OUR strength." (Philippians 4:13)

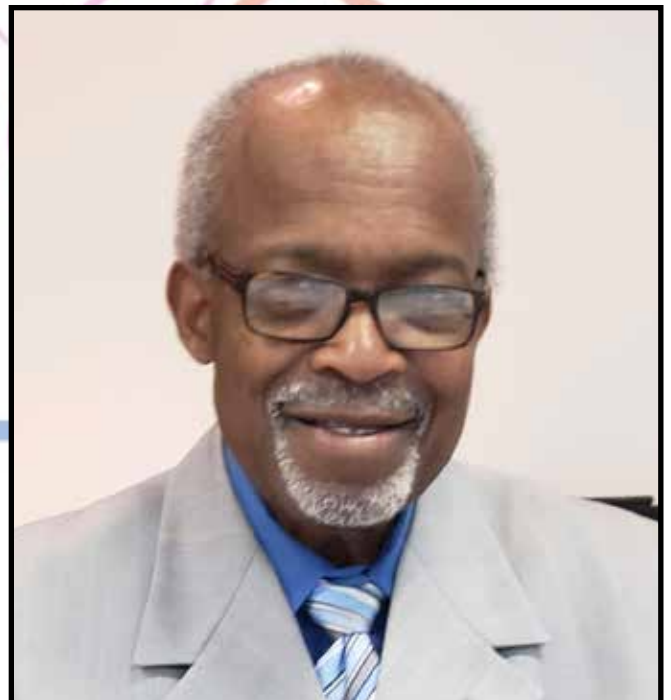

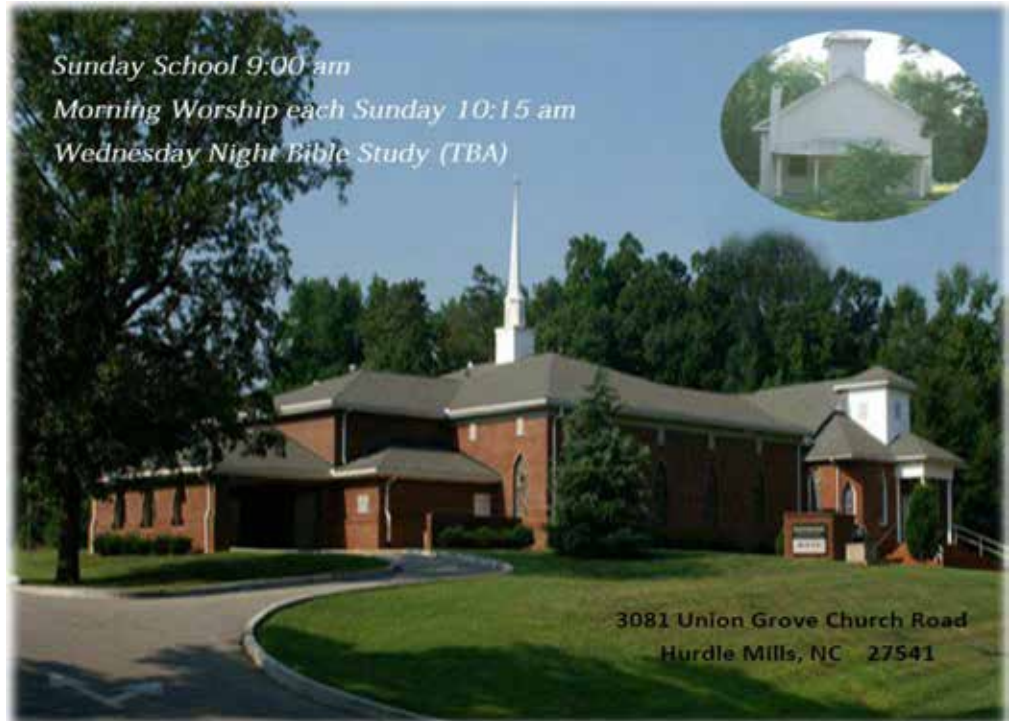
