Covid-19 Management Plan

Our Jr Sailing Commitment is to lead with COVID-19 recommended practices that help ensure the safety, and fun, of our students, our employees, and our community. Our club has spent time as a team to institute processes to ensure that the program is fun and safe. In advance and before the program starts we may adjust our policies and procedures from time-to-time to ensure compliance and safety. We will notify you of changes via email, and on our Jr Sailing website page.

COVID-19 Update:

The club is working to adjust to our procedures and facilities in an uncertain world. As of now, we intend to run our program for fun sailing instruction while complying with the guidelines of the state of Massachusetts as well as both state and local health agencies – our summer program will run with modifications described below!

Absent of new widely adopted technology in healthcare that offer a digital health pass (green, yellow or red), and more mandates, the following processes and facilities will be used to help manage safety at NSA. Students are strongly urged to preregister before the sailing session begins. Parents and guests will not be allowed out of the cars and on the club grounds. Staff and students will be temperature checked and complete a health surveyed before daily entrance to the club programs. Inside of the club house is off limits to the students, and the multiple sanitization stations, washing stations, and portable toilets will be provided.

Further, the club has changed the program to enable socially distanced teaching and meeting areas, and newly configured floating dock with fewer boats/students per floating dock, and per boat. If needed, contact tracking will be enabled via our processes. Unless sailing alone, or swimming, students will wear masks at all times. US sailing recommends nylon gaiters while sailing that dry fast, the club will provide a free gaiter for each student. Boats will be sanitized between each session.

COVID Controls, in Brief:

Preregistration/Registration/Payment in Advance:

In 2021 are asking sailing school families to please preregister electronically on our website as far in advance as possible if they plan to participate in sailing school this season. Our goal is to build a contactless preregistration and drop-off and pick-up process to comply with known and expected recommendations, rules and regulations, early digital preregistration will help to reduce risks of COVID. Student Care:

Masks are required at our facility and while sailing unless as the only person in the boat, or swimming. Social distancing measures are in place, as well as capacity limits across the class activities, on the land and on the water.

Staff Education:

All staff will be trained on the protocols for compliance with COVID controls for a Mass State Phase II governor's orders

Facility Cleaning Practices:

Cleaned with disinfectant

Preregistration w/no person-to-person contact

Check-in/Check-out w/no person-to-person contact

All sailboats boats disinfected after each session

High touch surfaces cleaned with disinfectant (bathrooms, faucets, etc.)
