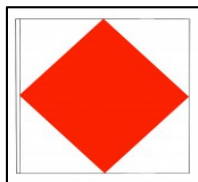
Juliet= C-E-C-E (F Start)

REEFING

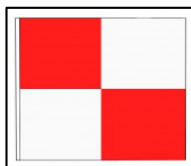
When Code Flag “F” is displayed or broadcast, all boats must carry a reef. Any boat crossing the finish line without it’s sail reefed will be disqualified.

Note: All crew are also required to wear personal buoyancy devices while the Reefing Flag is flown.



CANCELLATION

If the Race Committee deems conditions unsafe or unsatisfactory, the Cancellation flag will be flown.



POSTPONEMENT

If weather or safety conditions require the Race Committee to reassess the course and/or the entire Race, the Postponement flag will be flown.

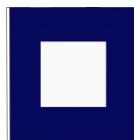
When lowered, boats may assume the starting sequence to follow

Note: Yellow Flag  designates ‘Finish’ set to be the reverse of every ‘Start’

- When turning at ‘A’ or ‘F’ the Pin and not the Committee Boat is the Mark.
- When ‘A’ ‘D’ or ‘F’ is between marks on any leg...ignore it. Only turn on marks with Yellow racing buoys.
- The ‘I Flag’ Rule is always in effect (No dipping line at start 1 minute prior to start)

RACING STARTS FOR EACH FLEET

1. Three Short Bursts
2. **Warning**-5 minutes Burgee up with sound
3. **Preparatory**-4 minutes Flag up with sound
4. **1 Minute**-1 minute Flag down with long sound
5. **Start**-0 minutes Burgee down with sound



Note: The second start sequence will not commence until all boats in the first start have cleared the starting line. **Participating boats,**

wanting to be scored in a race, have **FIVE MINUTES** to cross the starting line after the appropriate flag and starting horn is sounded.
