That we're not the same, you and me.'*

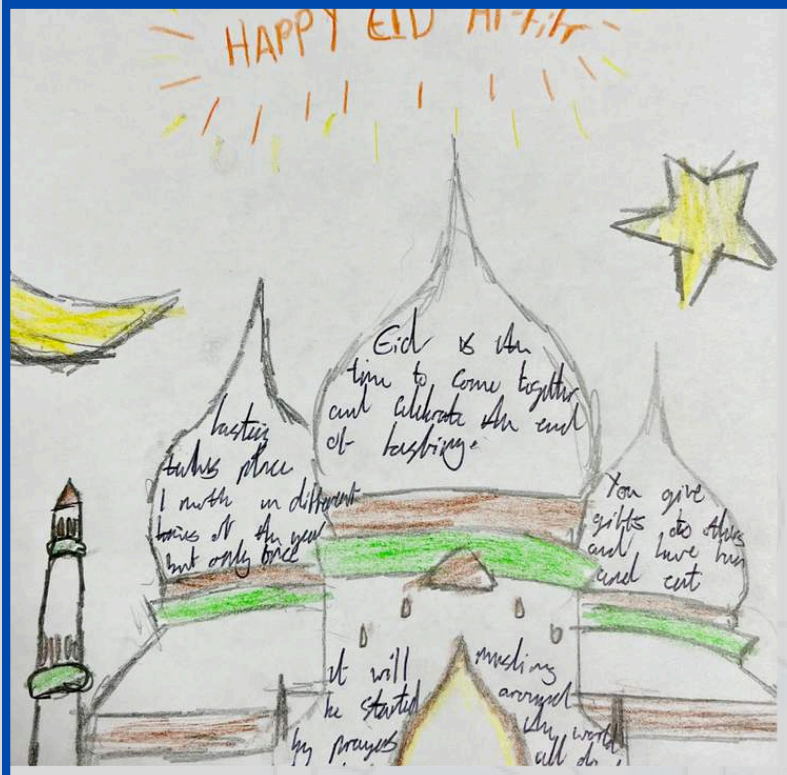
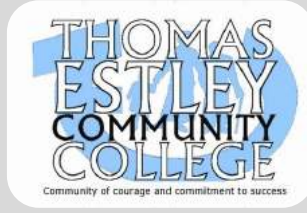


Mandi Collins – Trust Leader

Christian Union and Christian Connect Group

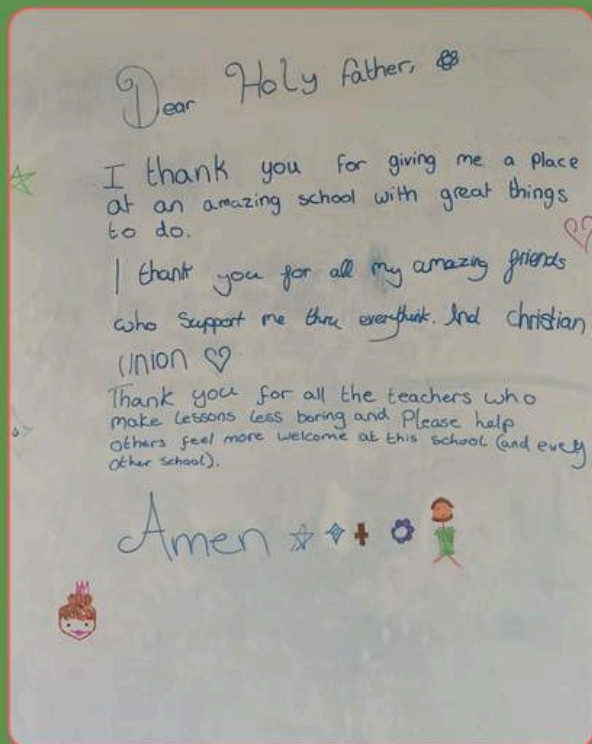
We have a Christian Union group at Thomas Estley led by our staff and students, Students meet and pray for the school, as well as encouraging one another, learning about the Bible and having fun together

Dear Holy Father,

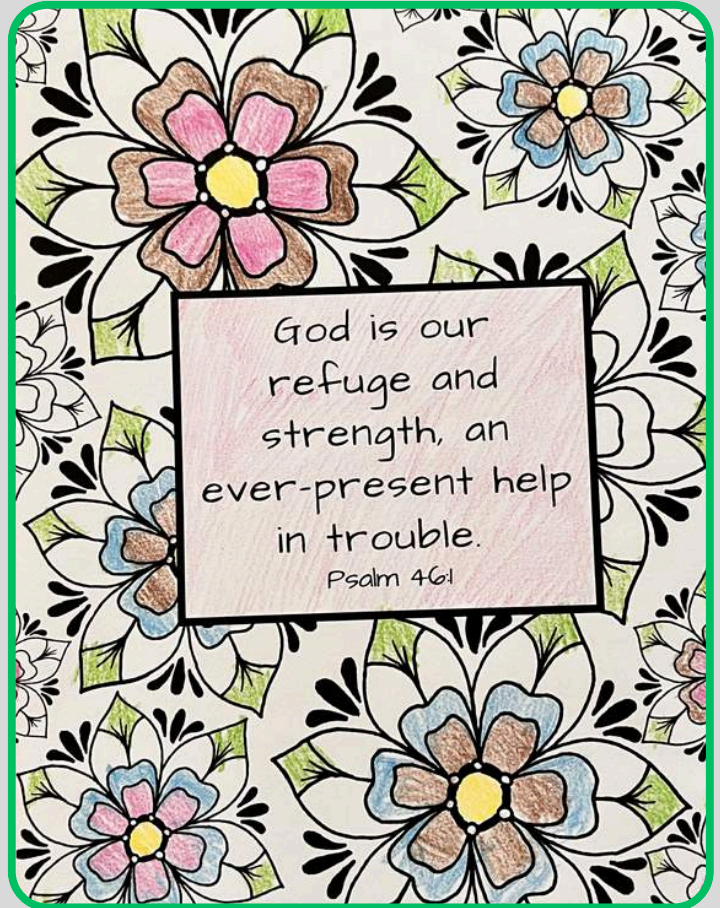
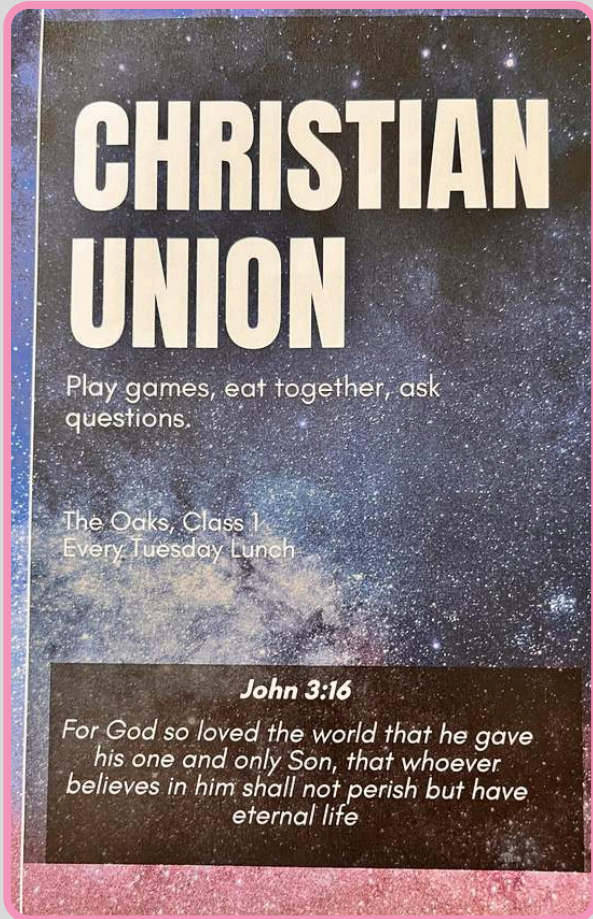
I thank you for giving me a place at an amazing school with great things to do. I thank you for all my amazing friends who support me through everything and Christian Union.

The Trust and Active Hinckley & Bosworth said a massive well done to the students who have been working tirelessly over the last term to become positivity ambassadors in their schools.

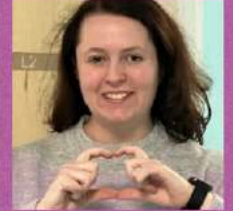
Our students of Richmond Primary have taken on training to allow them to support their peers and to shape the way they approach mental health and wellbeing to all pupils.



Richmond Primary Positivity Ambassadors

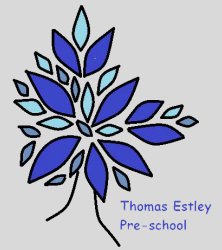


INTERNATIONAL Women's Day

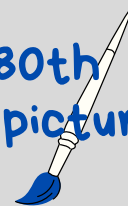


Success AT Thomas Estley Out of School Club
