<p>Classic Lady of the Day</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Style and originality • A traditional autumn/winter race wear look • Seasonally appropriate millinery that complements outfit • Grooming and presentation • Attention to detail with accessories ie clutch/bag, brooch, earrings, fur, gloves, hosiery etc • Outfit to complement wearer • Closed toe shoes • Tops or dresses with sleeves • Consideration of seasonally appropriate fabrics, colours & accessories 	<p>Gentleman of the Day</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Style and originality • Suit or separates • Seasonally appropriate millinery that complements outfit • Grooming and presentation • Attention to detail with accessories ie cufflinks, tie, tie pin etc • Outfit to complement wearer • Consideration of seasonally appropriate fabrics, colours & accessories

- This criteria is a basic set of guidelines that has been created by It's All About The Sash for use by clubs/committee's and may be adapted for use. These guidelines are the most popular points taken from an audit of the guidelines of a large amount of race clubs across Australia
- Category titles can also be easily adapted to suit clubs requirements ie Lady could be changed to Best Dressed, Gentleman could be adapted to Best Suited etc.
- Additional categories ie Couples/Duos, Children, Local etc can be adapted from the criteria above
