	This is a time to embrace the best of the season – think florals, straw, lace and bold colours, you can be creative with feathers, tulle and light weight fabrics.	Autumn/Winter millinery shifts with the changing of the weather – think felt, wool, leather, structure and sleek.	Trans-seasonal refers to materials which have qualities which can be used in both Spring/Summer and Autumn/Winter. Often the colour of the material denotes its appropriateness, for example, leather is regarded as a trans-seasonal material. In Spring/Summer you would expect to see leather in softer colours like white, pale pink, pale blue. In Autumn/Winter burgundy, black, browns would be most appropriate.
