Roaring Fork Recovery Support Center dba The Meeting Place was created in 2010 and incorporated as a 501c3 nonprofit in 2015. Created to provide a safe and supportive place for meetings, fellowship, educational activities, and social events for people in recovery, their families, and friends, The Meeting Place is the only organization of its kind in the Roaring Fork Valley, exclusively dedicated to providing consistent and affordable space for recovery meetings.

The Meeting Place ended 2020 better than ever, and is currently in the process of renewing its lease; unfortunately, the new lease includes a significant increase in rent. In August 2020 we launched an ambitious and successful fundraising campaign to prepare for this increase. We enter 2021 in a strong financial position, with an efficient and sustainable operational model.

Since the recent pandemic, The Meeting Place has adapted to be of maximum service to our community. After a short closure in March and April, we reopened with stringent safety protocols in compliance with county regulations and added additional meetings to diffuse the number of attendees. We immediately installed internet and a computer station, allowing for hybrid ZOOM/in person meetings. This technology is also available during off hours to those who may not have home computer or internet access.

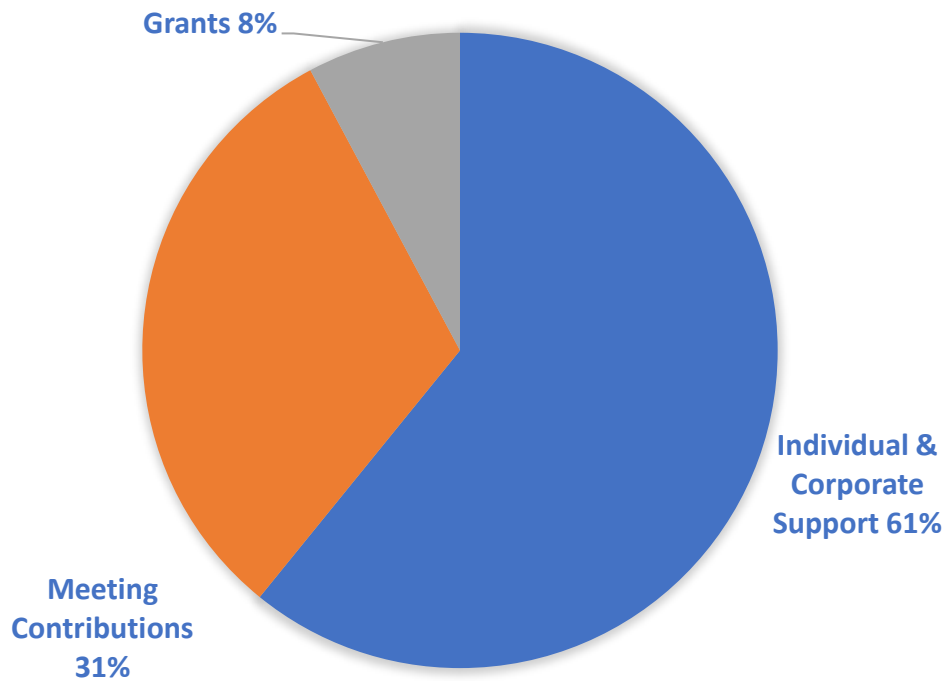

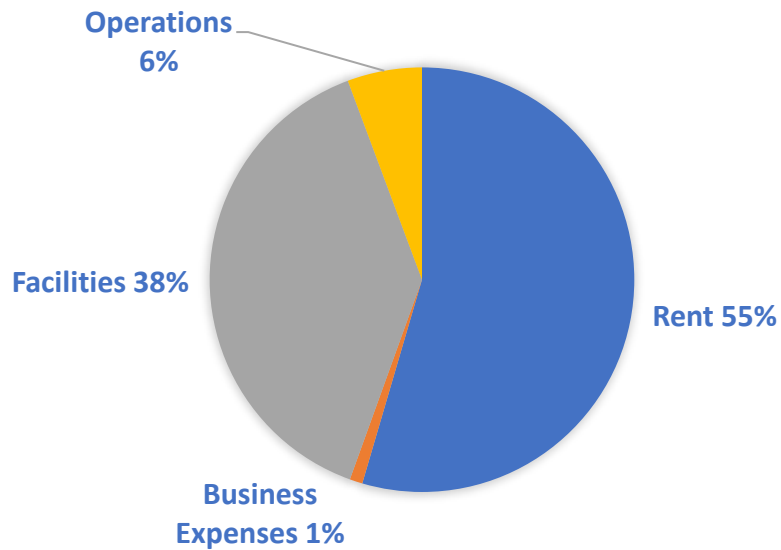
