Receiving your loved one into our care from a local hospital or home address (within 15mile radius)

Providing advice on certification required for the registration of death.

Attending to all extra documentation, if required for example arranging and placing of obituary notices, floral tributes, printing of funeral stationary making a receiving all necessary telephone calls, administrating charitable donations, catering and any other related service.

All staff and maintenance of our equipment and premises to facilitate arrangements for the preparation of care of your loved one.

The use of our chapel of rest for family and friends to visit by appointment if necessary.

Attendance and presence of funeral director and necessary personnel on the day of the funeral, including distributing attendance cards and Order of service were needed.
