TRAVEL TOPICS

- Golden Rule...stay golden and call out the gold.
- "Travel fast alone, and far together." We're traveling together for our trip; put each other first.
- Carry what you bring, and consider a travel wallet (neck, waist, etc.)
- Personal item max is often 18" x 14" x 8"
- Carry-on max is 22" x 14" x 9", to lift overhead without help.
- Checked bag max is 62" linear and 50 lbs.
- Wear comfortable layers, and bring snacks for your flight
- Bring passport, an ID is helpful, Global Entry if you have one, & a pen if you don't.


HOW TO DRESS
