- Complete HLTINF005 Maintain Infection Control Prevention for skin penetration treatments.
- First aid certification is also encouraged.

It is recommend that students be fully immunised against hepatitis B prior to course commencement.

attributes

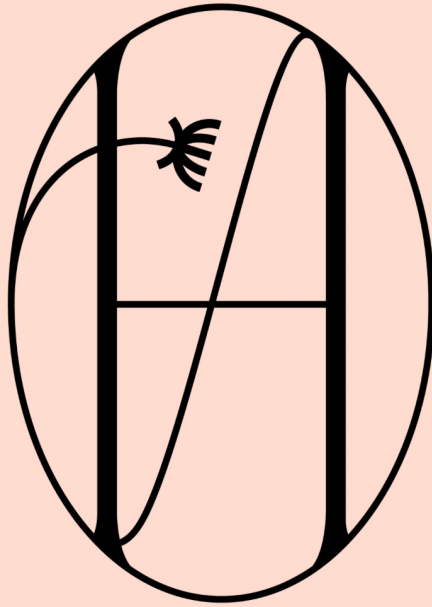
- good eyesight (aid required if needed)

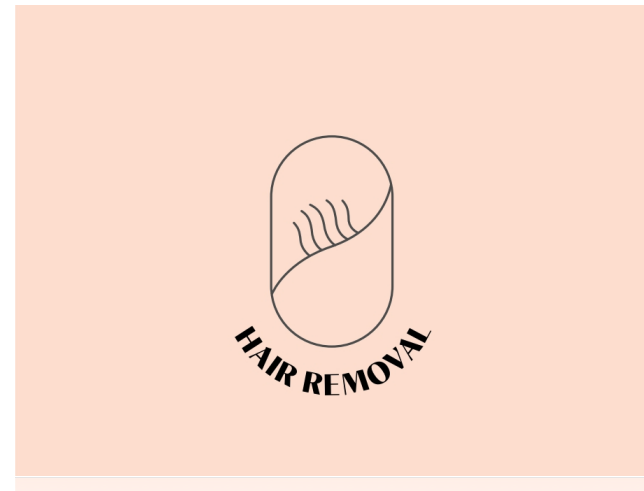

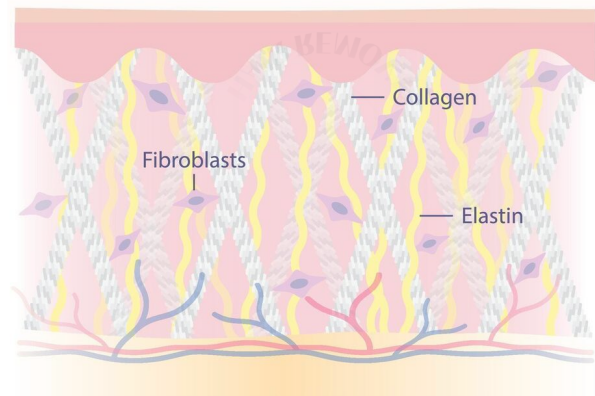

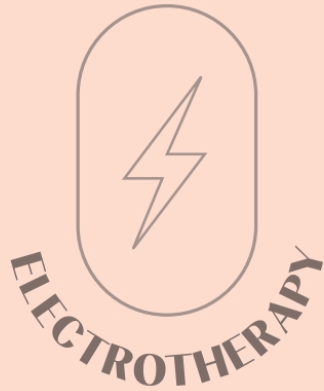

1. Satisfactory completion of **Part 1: Theory component and written assessment**.
2. **100% attendance** and satisfactory completion of all components of **Part 2: Practical Tuition**, including 4 or more live practice procedures (documented in student logbook).
3. Post-course satisfactory undertaking of required logged procedure hours (documented in the **student logbook**), including **6-8 corrective procedures** and **4-6 full procedures**, to demonstrate ongoing professional development. The **logbook must be submitted** before certification can be achieved.

*If the work demonstrated in the logbook is deemed unsatisfactory by not meeting professional standards and the above mentioned requirements, students will be directed to either undertake further training, at the student's expense, and/or further practical hours until satisfactory skill acquisition has been consistently demonstrated. In all cases, the HAIAA Academy will work closely with students to assist them in this process.

Please **NOTE**: Students will only be issued **Certificate of Completion** once all **Theory, Tuition** and evidence of practical **logbook** entries has been provided. All course fees must be paid in full for Certification to be granted. Under no circumstances are Qualifications issued otherwise.

Ongoing remote support will be provided for the duration of independent Case Study Period & course completion.

COMPENTANCY & CERTIFICATION

Upon successful completion of the practical component students will receive a **Certificate of Attendance** for nominated course which will allow them to start work in the chosen field of Electrology - Electroepilation.

Upon successful completion of all facets, including post course Case Studies components students will receive a **Certificate of Completion** for nominated course.

All post course independent practical Case studies before and after photos are to be submitted via WhatsApp for constructive feedback, safety and progress monitoring during the period of post practical completion.

All daily Faux skin mat practice and paper practice is to be submitted as a proof of practice post course.

Feedback will be given within 24-48 hours.

Independent practice must be completed within 6 months of initial training.

If students require further supervision with independent practice training rooms and supervision can be arranged at additional cost.

If a student is a beginner, we strongly recommend that they undertake more studies.

All prices are net prices and must be paid in full prior to course commencement. Changes, errors and misprints reserved.

Please note that students might have to at times enlist models for practical component and all Student and Demo models are required to pay fee (\$150 per procedure for up to 2hrs). Students can pre collect the fee and pay it to academy if models are to be arranged by students prior to training session.

Part 1:	pre study	(30hrs)
	Theoretic component, Training Manual and Health Guidelines for Skin Penetration Services two weeks prior to course commencement. The basis of this study is provided in the PDF document that will be posted to candidates to help them familiarise themselves with relevant HAIAA studies and infection control rules and regulations applicable to their state or territory. (please note this is not HLTINF005 Maintain Infection Control Prevention). During Pre Study time assistance is provided via email, WhatsApp and telephone, if requested. Completion of Part 1 is gained by following instructions outlined in enrolment letter which will be emailed to participants upon successful enrolment.

Morning theory covers industry history, occupational health and safety, hygiene, anatomy and physiology, contraindications, implant techniques, equipment and tool operation, skin theory and correction, application and parameters, product knowledge, skin types, basic photography, insurance, portfolio / logbook, pre-procedure preparation and post procedure care. treatment plan Afternoon topics covered include formulating a treatment plan, preparing the treatment area, operator preparation, products, client preparation, numbing regulations, performing a patch test, do's and don'ts, demo of the art and science behind techniques learned, Anatomical and morphology types, understanding product, equipment & skin types. exercise and practice on Faux skin mat. Consultation role play and work station set up. Homework.
