Horse Numbers- every horse will be allocated a chest number prior to the show. The number will be advised for you to print. Numbers are to be worn by all horses when competing.

HORSE REGULATIONS

Special Note:	Due to the large number of sections being offered, rings will not be held up. Every endeavour has been made to prevent sections clashing. Competitors must decide which section will take priority.
Age of Horses:	The age of horses will date from 1 st August.
Age of Competitors:	Taken on the day of the event.
Breed Events:	<p>Competitors entering breed events must be current financial members, where required, of the breed society class they are entering. Horses must be properly registered with the applicable breed society(s).</p> <p>Proof of registration & current membership may be requested on the day. Spot checks may be undertaken. Competitors found to be non-compliant with this rule may be disqualified from the event.</p> <p>Classes listed for Arabian Amateur Owners or Riding Pony Newcomers must present their cards prior to the classes commencing.</p>
Championships:	Winners of Champions in Open rings must not compete in the same events in the other rings.
Children's Mount:	Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre. Please note that straight bar snaffles, drop nosebands, whips and spurs are not allowed.
Competitor Behaviour:	<p>All competitors and their associates must behave in an appropriate manner towards judges, stewards, show organisers and other competitors at all times during the event. Abusive behaviour will not be tolerated.</p> <p>Any inappropriate behaviour reported by judges or stewards and/or witnessed by a member of the organising committee may result in elimination from the event. The organising committee may also forward the competitor's details and the reported/witnessed behaviour to EA and VAS Ltd for further sanction(s).</p>
Disease:	The signing of the Certificate of entry of any animal shall be taken as a guarantee that the animal is free from disease, as far as is known to the exhibitor. In case of infectious disease being spread through or by an exhibit, the exhibitor shall be held responsible. Should there be any reason to suspect an exhibit is either diseased or dangerous, the Society reserves the right of refusing admittance to or removing the same from the grounds at the expense of the exhibitor.
District Events	District is within 80kms radius of Ballarat Post Office.
Entries:	The Society has the right and power to reject or cancel any entry at any time without assigning any reason. Refunds will not be given for any reason.
Entry Fees	<p>Entries: \$8.00 per class</p> <p>NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED</p> <p>BAPS Membership - Cost \$65.00</p>
DOGS	No Dogs permitted in the Showgrounds.
Gate Entry	\$10 per car and float. Gate entry fees are to be paid at the time of entry.
First Ridden	Height limit is 12.2hh and the riders must be 5 years & under 12 years old. Pony is to be ridden in a simple snaffle bit, cavesson nose band, cane must be no longer than 40cm, NO whips or spurs.
Good Hands Competition Rules:	<p>Good Hands competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability. Mount, saddle and costume will not be taken into account. Special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony.</p> <p>Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre. The mouthpiece must be smooth and of one metal with or without a cavesson noseband. A gear check may take place. Please note that straight bar snaffles, drop nosebands, whips and spurs are not allowed.</p> <p>Finals will be held at the 2026 VAS Saddle Horse Championships.</p>
Headgear:	All riders riding a horse in an EA or affiliated event must wear protective headgear to the current AS/NZ Standard. The retaining harness must be secured and fastened at all times. Riders without approved headgear will be ineligible to compete until the headgear is rectified. This rule applies to all events
Intermediate Ridden Events:	Open to horses, ponies or riders that have not won a Championship at any Agricultural Show. The winner of an Intermediate event is eligible to compete in the championship that is appropriate to the winner's height.

Judging:	<p>A competitor may not compete before a judge if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The judge or their business partner provided privately arranged tuition to the horse or competitor/exhibitor in the last 6 months (not including open clinics); or • Where the competitor/exhibitor has provided privately arranged tuition to the Judge or has trained or leased a horse owned by the Judge within the last 6 months. (not including open clinics) <p>Definitions: per EA Show Horse Rules and Guidelines (and amendments).</p> <p>All judges will be published on the website http://www.ballaratshow.org.au/</p>
Leading Rein:	<p>Lead rein pony (mare or gelding) not exceeding 12.0hh ridden by a child 3 years and under 8 years old. The pony must be shown in a snaffle bridle with a leather lead rein, held by the handler in the left hand, attached to the cavesson noseband. A narrow strap may be attached to the front of the small saddle for the child to hold if necessary. The handler may carry a cane but the rider must have neither whip or spurs.</p>
Marshalling:	<p>Any competitor placing their horse in any unauthorised area will be liable to disqualification by the stewards. Each competitor must keep contact with the Marshall's Office to ensure they are ready for their event.</p>
Measuring:	<p>Current RASV or EA/EV/SHC will be recognised.</p>
Naming:	<p>Names of horses must be given at the time of entry. For riding events the name of the rider must be given.</p>
Novice Ridden and Rider events:	<p>Novices have not won a first placing in a similar class to which they are entered at any Agricultural Show. The winner of a novice event is eligible to compete in the championship that is appropriate to the winner's height.</p>
Open Ridden and Rider Events:	<p>No restriction placed on the horse's or ponies performance, as long as it comes within the specified ruling. Open exhibits cannot compete in Show Hunter events.</p>
Parking:	<p>Competitors are requested to park vehicles and floats as directed by the parking attendant.</p> <p>Parking restrictions will apply for OHS compliance. You may be asked to move your vehicle if it is not parked appropriately. It is a condition of entry that you comply with the parking officers or show officials instructions.</p>
Prize Ribbons:	<p>Ribbons will be given for the first three placing's except where otherwise specified.</p>
Show Hunters:	<p>To have more substance than the modern show horse, but still maintain the quality. They are expected to move freely at all paces. They may be expected at any time to gallop for the judge, but are not expected to jump. Presentation of Show hunters is more subdued. There must be no coloured brow bands or multi-coloured hair ribbons or flowers on riders. Junior riders should not wear top boots.</p> <p>Show Hunters cannot compete in the open events.</p>
Stallions:	<p>Stallions and Colts must be handled by a person over 18 years of age. Exceptions may be made for saddle stallions under 12hh, upon representation to the Society.</p> <p>All Stallions and Colts are to be led in bridles with bits, except where this is contradictory to breed association rules.</p>
Substitution of horses:	<p>Where any horse entered for the show is unable to compete due to illness or injury, another horse in the same ownership may be substituted, but <u>only into the same section</u>. Competitors wishing to substitute another horse to different will have to pay separate entry fees.</p>
Swabbing:	<p>Random Swabbing may take place</p>
VAS Ltd and Barastoc First Season Newcomers:	<p>Eligibility: For ridden Hacks, Galloways and Ponies competing in their first season under saddle. Newcomers must not have been shown under saddle prior to 1 January of the year of the event.</p>
VAS. Ltd Saddle Horse Championships:	<p>Eligibility: All Champion & Reserve Champion Open Ridden Hacks, Galloways or Ponies and Champion and Reserve Champion Ridden Shetlands from respective classes.</p> <p>Only one qualification from one open ring at the Ballarat Show can be used to qualify for the V.A.S. Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.</p>
VAS Ltd Champion Rider:	<p>Eligibility: Winning riders in specified age groups (10yrs and under 12yrs and under 14yrs, 14yrs and under 16yrs, 16yrs and under 18yrs, 18 and under 21yrs, 21yrs and under 30 years, 30 years and over, as per V.A.S. Ltd) from rings 1, 2 and 3. To qualify, entrants must have won a riding class at a V.A.S. Ltd Affiliated show between 01/05/25 and 31/12/2026</p>
Warm Up:	<p>Horses are only permitted on the arena for competition and judging. Warm up and practice is permitted in designated areas only.</p>
