All ponies must be registered with Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc.

Miniature Ponies must not exceed 87cm.

Appendix Ponies Height 87.01cm to 91.5cm

All Stallions and Colts 2 years and over to be bitted.

Ribbons to 3rd Place

Entries: \$10.00 per class

Facility Fee \$16 per pony (If you have paid in another ring which breed ??)

Once of Administration Fee: \$25 (If you have paid to another Society which one ??)

VICTORIAN BRANCH - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. COVIDSafe rules apply on the day and MUST be adhered to
2. Current copies of your membership cards and both sides of your pony's registration papers / foal recordings that you are entering in the show MUST be sent with your entry form
3. Members must supply a copy of their PIC number (Property Identification Code) with their entry form as this is a LEGAL REQUIREMENT to register your property where your ponies have come from
4. All exhibits must be registered with the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc, and in the name of a current financial member.
5. All exhibitors / handlers must be a current financial member
6. All exhibitors / handlers must be in control of their pony at all times one pony one handler except in the child handler, ridden and harness classes
7. All handlers must be suitably attired in the show ring as per new rules of the Constitution.
8. Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc. will not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or loss of ponies, competitors or spectators or any of their belongings or any other person or property whatsoever.
9. All protests must be lodged with the committee within 15 minutes of the completion of the class, together with a \$50.00 fee. This will be reimbursed if the protest is upheld. The Show Organisers decision is final
10. All entire's 2 years and over must be shown in a recognised bridle and bit and handled by a competent Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc member 18 year and over.
11. Any colts under 2 years must be handled by an Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc. Member 18 years and over.
12. Age of handler is at the day of the show. Juniors must be members in their own right.
13. All Colts & Stallions must be double tined if outside the float at all times
14. Classes may be split at the Judge's discretion if needed
15. No refunds will be given
16. No Late entries will be accepted after closing date
17. Ponies that have already been entered for the show and wish to entry another class on the day they may do so at double the entry
18. All Ponies may be measured on the day of the show before competing, if any pony is Microchipped the owner must produce a reader for the identify process for the Measurer and if a pony measure over 87cm they may be eligible to compete in the Appendix section on the day. New rules will apply
19. Members with ponies that show any indication of diseases e.g. Respiratory Infections will be asked to immediately remove their ponies from the grounds.
20. Ribbon placing will be decided by show day
21. Driven and Ridden Ponies must be 3 years and over
22. A competent Australian Miniature Pony Society member must LEAD all foals. Foals may only accompany dams in the led classes
23. Exhibits in broodmare classes must be either visibility in foal or have a foal at foot or be able to provide a vet certificate to verify the mare will foal in the current season
24. Foals of the current season can NOT be clipped
25. Approved Aus / NZ protective headgear must be worn at all times for exercising, ridden and harness classes.
26. Any Member who is ill-treating a pony will be prohibited from showing on the day
27. Photographs may be taken on Show day and maybe published in relevant media outlets as part of a record of the Show. In signing the Entry Form, you are agreeing to the publication of said photos. If you do not wish to have your Pony photographed, you must submit a letter, with your Entry Form to the Show secretary
28. AMPS® Social Media Policy is now in place and Members need to mindful that inappropriate use of Social Media may lead to legal actions
29. Appendix Ponies can only entry in the Appendix Classes after they have been measured on the day of the show
30. Appendix and AMPS® Classes CANNOT be combined together as per the rules of the constitution
31. Members for safety reasons please refrain from KNEELING DOWN in front of your Pony in the ring.
32. No loose dogs on the ground
