

GENERAL PLANTING GUIDELINES

All plants must be healthy, vigorous material, free of pests & diseases & Florida #1 grade or better, unless otherwise indicated.

All plants must be container grown or balled & burlapped (8&8) as indicated in the plant list.

All plants must be traight trunked, full-headed & meet all requirements specified.

All plants are subject to approval of the landscape designer & property owner before, during, & after installation until the date of the final acceptance.

All trees are to be guyed or staked as instructed by designer if different than Master Landscape Plan indicates.

All plants & planting areas must be completely mulched to a minimum depth of 3" using Chocolate Shredded Mulch. (existing Pine Straw Beds surrounding Pine Trees to remain Pine Straw)

Prior to construction, the landscape contractor shall be responsible for locating all underground utilities, structure, site appurtenances, etc. that is or could be affected by the landscape contractor is responsible for verifying all quantities shown on these plans.

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The landscape contractor is responsible for maintaining all plantings (including, but not limited to: watering, spraying, mulching, fertilizing, etc.) of planting areas and lawns until the work is accepted in total to the landscape designer and/or the property owner.

Any plant material which dies, runs brown or defoliates (prior to total acceptance of the work) shall be promptly removed from the site and replaced with material of the same species, quantity, size, and meeting all plant list specifications. Normal plant material shall be warranted for a period of 3 months after completion. Palms and trees shall be warranted for (1) year. Warranty period starts after larghacement accepted.

All disturbed areas of existing sod, shall be re-sodded, sod type to be \$t\$, Augustine Floratam if existing sod cannot be determined. Contractor to notify property owner of all sod replacement

Work performed shall comply with the following: A. These General Notes, and Construction Documents and Specifications. B. All applicable local, state and federal codes, ordinances and regulations. All codes listed in Specifications and Drawings shall be inclusive of all codes, regulations and requirements adopted by the state of Florida, including all amendments.
 Source of base information is Dameron Designs and is assumed to be correct. Report any discrepancies immediately to the property Owner's

representative.
• Verify locations of pertinent site improvements installed under other contracts. If any part of this plan cannot be followed due to site conditions, contact

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Dameron Designs' representative and/or property owner for instructions prior to commencing work.
 Contact local underground utility services for utility location and identification, prior to commencing work.
 Perform excavation in the vicinity of underground utilities with care and by hand, if necessary. The contractor bears full responsibility of this work and the
disruption of damage to utilities shall be repaired immediately and at no expense to the property owner or designer.
 Berm dirt / Soil must be free of foreign debris and good clean fill dirt, to promote a healthy plant life and growing conditions.

SPECIAL NOTES:

BOULDERS – (10Lg, 12Med, 16Sm) boulders. Homeowner choice – Strategically placed throughout landscape. To be included in project bid Phase #2.

• All plant material shall remain unless designated for removal. Remove designated items shown on the plan to the full depth of their construction unless

Verify the location and dimensions of the item/s to be removed prior to the commencement of the work.
All concrete and asphalt removal shall be saw cut. Edges of material to remain shall be shored up and protected during construction to preserve edge intact. Repairs to damaged edges to be done with care and at no cost to the property owner. (if applicable)
Items encountered below grade and not shown on the drawings shall be brought to the attention of the landscape design. Landscape contractor to be responsible for the removal of all unwanted materials found below grade.
Salvage existing materials as indicated on plans. Remove (if necessary) salvaged materials as indicated with care and store on site; clean all debris and construction material from salvaged items; reuse as directed by landscape designer.
Remove demolished materials from site. Disposal by burning and/or burying is prohibited.
Contact the local underground service update for utility location and identification prior to demolition.
The location of existing utilities as shown on the plans may vary in relation to actual conditions.

GEMERAL IRRIGATION NOTES:

These plans are to be used for conceptual irrigation plan only and for general purposes of bidding a residential irrigation alteration of existing system, & installation.



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
