

All plants must be healthy, vigorous material, free of pests & diseases & Florida #1 grade or better, unless otherwise indicated.

All trees are to be guyed or staked as instructed by designer if different than Master Landscape Plan indicates.

All plants are subject to approval of the landscape designer & property owner before, during, & after installation until the date of the final acceptance.

2. Landscape contractor shall verify the plant quantities. Plant symbols on the landscape construction plan supersede quantities in the plant list.

. Excessive plant material shown on plan and not installed shall be deducted from final invoice and promptly removed from the property.

4. Berm dirt / Soil must be free of foreign debris and good clean fill dirt, to promote a healthy plant life and growing conditions.

ontact the local underground service update for utility location and identification prior to demolition. The location of existing utilities as shown on the plans may vary in relation to actual conditions.

warranted for a period of 3 months after completion. Palms and trees shall be warrantied for (1) year. Warranty period starts after latest replacement is accepted.

All plants & planting areas must be completely mulched to a minimum depth of 3" using Chocolate Shredded Mulch. (existing Pine Straw Beds surrounding Pine Trees to remain Pine Straw)

Plant legend indicates if plant material is to be planted inside the container or removed and planted directly in the ground. Please see the last column (notes) of the plant legend.

Prior to construction, the landscape contractor shall be responsible for locating all underground utilities, structure, site appurtenances, etc. that is or could be affected by the landscape construction.

1. All disturbed areas of existing sod, shall be re-sodded, sod type to be St, Augustine Floratam if existing sod cannot be determined. Contractor to notify property owner of all sod replacement and species.

1. The landscape contractor is responsible for maintaining all plantings (including, but not limited to: watering, spraying, mulching, fertilizing, etc.) of planting areas and lawns until the work is accepted in total by the landscape designer and/or the property owner.

O. Any plant material which dies, runs brown or defoliates (prior to total acceptance of the work) shall be promptly removed from the site and replaced with material of the same species, quantity, size, and meeting all plant list specifications. Normal plant material shall be

5. All mulch (Chocolate Shredded Mulch) to be approved by the landscape designer and the owner. Provide samples to the landscape designer for review and approval prior to installation of much. Mulch shall be free of foreign debris or deleterious material. Mulch shall not be 6. 

All plants must be container grown or balled & burlapped (B&B) as indicated in the plant list.

All trees must be straight trunked, full-headed & meet all requirements specified.

4. In size grading multi-stem trees, height shall take precedence over caliper










POST TO BE DRIVEN MIN. 12"INTO UNDISTRUBED GROUND TYP. GROUND COVER PLANTING DETAL




