



2020 Annual Activity Report

Fix-it Days/RASCAL Days

- Due to the coronavirus pandemic and the statewide shutdown, April's monthly Fix-it Day was cancelled. The regularly scheduled Fix-It Day clinics were held monthly at the Fredericktown Veterinary Clinic.
- One overflow Fix-it Day was held at the Fredericktown Veterinary Clinic in July.
- Two Rascal Days (mobile spay/neuter clinic) were held in Fredericktown in June and September.
- Total cats with spay/neuter surgery in Fix-it Days and RASCAL Days-407; 246 females spayed, 161 males neutered.
- Total clients in Fix-it Days and Rascal Days-287 individuals.
- Counties represented in Fix-it Days: Knox-168 individuals (59%); Richland-59 individuals (21%); Morrow-38 individuals (13%); Licking-7 individuals (2%). Other counties represented: Delaware, Holmes, Tuscarawas, Coshocton, Ashland, and Crawford.

Trap/Neuter/Return (T/N/R) Program

- Because of the pandemic, start of our T/N/R program was delayed until June.
- Number of trap/neuter/return projects-10.
- Number of cats t/n/r'ed-21 females, 23 males.
- Counties represented in trap/neuter/return projects-Knox (7 projects), Delaware (2 projects), and Richland (1 project).

Fosters/Adoptions

- Two litters of kittens (6 kittens) from two trap/neuter/return projects and two abandoned kittens were surrendered to SNACK, socialized, and fostered by three volunteers.
- All kittens were vetted, spayed or neutered and were adopted or went to rescue. One kitten died.

Other

- Volunteers completed a group quilt and held a drawing as a fundraiser. We made over \$400.
- The group moved from paper/mail-in registration for Fix-it Days to an online system during the summer. Thus far, clinics fill within a day of posting the online form and the system has been very successful.
- Facebook followers grew to over 800 during the year.
