Sedona - Depart 7am - Return 6pm - \$155 per person

Verde Canyon Train Trip & The casual grace of train travel never goes out of style. Indoor cars are climate-controlled and each has a restroom. Music mixed with fascinating educational narration of the 40 mile round-trip, thoughtfully chosen for their historical significance and rockin' beat. Dinner at Blazin M Ranch - Western World Reenactments – Dinner & Show – Overnight in Cottonwood – The Next day enjoy a Winery tour - the Verde Valley is home to world-class wineries and vineyards. The high elevation, rich volcanic earth, and mild climate make it ideal for grape growing of award winning wines.

Tombstone * San Xavier Mission * Pima Air & Space Museum

Early morning departure from Wickenburg, 4 hour bus ride to Visit the famous OK Corral and Big Nose Kate's Saloon in Tomstone, AZ. Hear tales, legends and reenactments of American outlaws in this legendary frontier outpost, where money, fame and lust were always at odds with the law. We will enjoy dinner together and spend the night in historic Tucson. The next morning, after breakfast included, you'll also visit historic San Xavier de Bac Mission, an active mission started by the Spanish Catholics ministering to the Natives. Then we will go to the Pima Air & Space Museum, one of the world's largest non-government funded aerospace museums. The museum features a display of nearly 300 aircraft spread out over 80 acres on a campus occupying 127 acres.

1 night/2 day - Grand Canyon Train - from \$495 each

Depart Wickenburg mid-morning – Arrive Back to Wickenburg around 9pm next day 3 hour bus trip to Williams – Check into your hotel and have time to walk around Route 66 historic Williams. Dinner provide at hotel Restaurant. Evening at leisure. Next Morning, board train after breakfast (Included). Snacks and soft drinks included on the train. 3 hour scenic train ride - Enjoy more than 3 hours at the canyon as the train drops you right in the Historic Village at the South Rim.
