

January 26 -27: Tucson

From Wickenburg we will have a 4 hour bus ride to Tombstone. We will visit the famous OK Corral and Big Nose Kate's Saloon and hear tales, legends and reenactments of American outlaws in this legendary frontier outpost, where money, fame and lust were always at odds with the law.

Lunch will be on your own as we have some free time there.

We will check into the hotel, and enjoy dinner together (included) and spend the night in historic Tucson. The next morning, after breakfast included, you'll also visit historic San Yavier de Rac Mission, an active mission started by the

Xavier de Bac Mission, an active mission started by the Spanish Catholics ministering to the Natives. Then we will go to the Pima Air & Space Museum, one of the world's largest non-government funded aerospace museums. The museum features a display of nearly 300 aircraft spread out over 80 acres on a campus occupying 127 acres. We will head back to Wickenburg with a stop for a late lunch along way.

We leave Wickenburg and first stop is the Verde Canyon Train. The casual grace of train travel never goes out of style. Indoor cars are climatecontrolled and each has a restroom. Comfortable seating, thoughtful décor and friendly, informative attendants add to the beauty of this remote wilderness without sacrificing the luxury of comfort. Including an outdoor viewing car. Music mixed with fascinating educational narration of the 40 mile round-trip, thoughtfully chosen for their historical significance and rockin' beat. Check into our hotel with time to relax. Tonight we will enjoy a fun dinner at Blazin M Ranch - Western World Reenactments - Dinner & Show – Overnight in Cottonwood – The Next day enjoy a Winery tour - the Verde Valley is home to world-class wineries and vineyards. The high elevation, rich volcanic earth, and mild climate make it ideal for award winning wines. Lunch and snacks available at winery. We will head back later in the afternoon to arrive early evening.

May 20-May 31: Israel

Then in the afternoon we will go to Lowell Observatory and visit newly opened Giovale Open Deck Observatory, a state-of-the-art observing plaza with 6 telescopes for guests to explore space. We will take a break for dinner and come back after sunset for night viewing. Astronomy Discovery Center, is scheduled to be open early 2024, which will feature a roof-top "open planetarium". Rather than a traditional enclosed planetarium in which guests view images, this one takes advantage of Flagstaff's exquisitely dark skies

to look at the real thing: stars and their celestial bodies in their natural setting. We will go back to our hotel for the night.

Day 2 We will depart after breakfast and make stops on our return to Wickenburg. Walnut Canyon:

Time to hike along the Rim or Island Trails and view ancient pueblos and cliff dwellings.





Meteor Crater: Spend some time at the world's best preserved meteorite impact site.

Stop in Winslow for Lunch and "standing on the corner".



Last stop is a drive through Petrified Forest; best known for globally significant Late Triassic fossils. We will drive through loop with stops along route






We will arrive back to Wickenburg in the early evening.
